I am writing to express my support for DaVita's proposal to establish a 16-station dialysis facility at 3934 West 24th Street, Chicago, Illinois 60623. Lawndale Dialysis will improve access and essential dialysis treatment for Chicago residents who reside in my Ward. This new location will ensure continued access to dialysis services for our community.

I support this site for the dialysis facility, and I believe that this project will help meet the health care needs of my Ward. As such, I fully support DaVita's application for a certificate of need to establish Lawndale Dialysis in my Ward.

Unfortunately, the kidney failure incident rate in the area community is much higher than in the general population.
