Dear Mr. Galassie,

I am writing in **opposition** to Vista Health System's proposal for a new hospital in Lake County. As an area physician, my patients are my number one priority. I am concerned that a new hospital in Lake County is not in their best interests, as it will duplicate existing services, result in an unnecessary increase in patient transfers, and jeopardize quality of care to patients in the area.

No question, healthcare is trending away from inpatient care. Procedures that once required an overnight stay can now be done on an outpatient basis. Ambulatory care centers are the way of the future – particularly in areas like Lake County that already have an excess of inpatient beds.

It is also important to note that Vista's proposed hospital offers only limited services and would not meet specialty care needs. For many high-level health services, patients would have to transfer to another regional facility like Advocate Condell Medical Center in Libertyville. This proposed facility will result in an increase in unnecessary patient transfers.

No one will argue that access to care is critical. However, in time-sensitive medical situations, all county residents are already within 15 minutes of emergency departments. Among those emergency departments is Vista's current Freestanding Emergency Center in Lindenhurst. Plain and simple, Lake County residents are already well-served when it comes to healthcare.

It is with my patients in mind that I oppose this project. Not only does it fail to bring new resources to the community, it jeopardizes the high-quality care that residents of Lake County currently enjoy.

It is with my constituents' interests in mind that I express my concerns over Vista Health System's proposal for a new Lake County hospital. On their behalf, I urge a thoughtful review of this application.

The existing area hospitals are some of the biggest employers and economic engines in Lake County. These strong community partners supply thousands of primary and secondary jobs, not to mention their significant economic impact on the surrounding areas and generous contributions to the fabric of life here. Simply put, we need to keep these hospitals strong for our communities. By pulling away critical patient volumes, a new and unneeded hospital in Lindenhurst would do the opposite.

It should also be noted that Lake County residents are still recovering from the recession that has impacted so many Illinois residents in recent years. Now is not the time to saddle them with the burden of underused medical centers. Beyond the initial expense of building a hospital, it is extremely costly to maintain hospital operations. The proposed facility may drive up healthcare costs to our constituents at a time when they can least afford it.

No question, quality healthcare is already one of Lake County's biggest assets. Right now, the county has six full-service hospitals, in addition to Freestanding Emergency Centers, ambulatory surgery centers and medical office buildings. This is a well-served region -- with just enough patients to sustain the major hospitals. Adding a new and unneeded hospital would jeopardize the first-rate specialty services and top-notch care that local residents have come to rely on.

I cannot support a project that is potentially more harmful to the region than helpful, and I urge the Board to consider the repercussions of approving Vista's proposal for a new hospital.
