Please DO NOT close the Warren G. Murray Developmental Center in Centralia, Illinois. It has been the home of my brother, Jim, for 48 years. Jim is now 57 years old. This is the best center in the entire state when it comes to providing care for the severely disabled citizens of Illinois. Our family knows because we have spent a great deal of time at the Murray Center. The caring staff has saved my brother's life on at least three occasions. The facility itself is wonderful. With its working pool, beautiful gardens, open campus, and sparkling clean buildings it has been a safe, clean home for our brother Jim. What a relief not to have worried about Jim's care these past years. Our state needs to provide these services for the families in south central Illinois. The loss of the Murray Center will present incredible hardships to our family and to many others. At the present time our family lives 2 hours from the Murray Center and we are able to visit Jim and attend important meetings regarding his care and therapy services. Jim's IEP's have documented for years his need for a high level of care like that provided at Murray Center. He is not a candidate for a group home placement. He has no language, is low-functioning, is bi-polar, has behavior issues, and is a choking risk. Closure of this facility will have a tremendously negative impact on Jim. In fact, the family worries that it might kill him to leave the only home he has known for 48 years because he suffers tremendous anxiety with even small changes. The community of Centralia has always been 100% supportive of the Murray Center. Many residents work at the facility and its closure would devastate not only this community but many of the smaller surrounding communities. These hardworking, caring, tax paying citizens do not deserve to have their jobs taken away, especially when they have done such exemplary work. You will not be able to duplicate the quality of this work force anywhere else in the state.

Our family urges you to use common sense, intelligence, fairness, and decency and deny the DHS application for project 13-058.

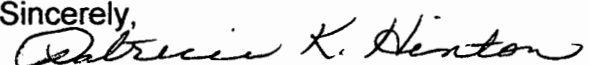

I am the guardian of Leilani Boyd. Leilani is 70 years old woman with an IQ of 05. She is an infant in the body of an adult. She is non-ambulatory. She has been unable to reach a goal of propelling her wheel chair 6 feet. Due to attempting to eat inedible objects and rectal digging she requires checking every 15 minutes, 24 hours a day, for her own safe being. As all infants need, she requires assistance in all aspects of her life from feeding to diaper changing.

Leilani was at Howe Center in Tinley Park where she was abused. The police investigated to find how a person who cannot walk had a broken leg and why she had bruises. Nothing was proven. Her transfer to Murray Center was and has continued to be a blessing. Closing Murray Center is a bad idea.

I cannot imagine the challenge that Murray Center faces with patients such as her. They attend to her needs, as well as other patients, and their medical requirements. Challenge is an understatement. With the excellent care that she and others are receiving, I can't imagine the devastating effect of relocating Leilani and others to a home or another facility.

I am asking, actually pleading, that you keep Murray Center open. I am not only her guardian, I am her brother. I am concerned about her care.

WHEREAS, the closure of this facility will result in devastating and long lasting effects on the current residents of Murray Center; and

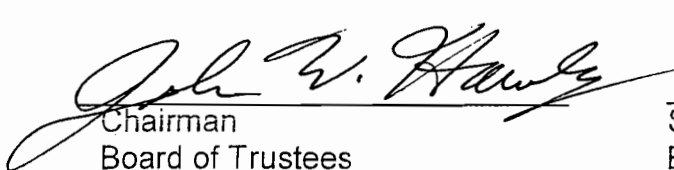
WHEREAS, the closure of this facility will result in devastating and long lasting effects on the economies of the region; and

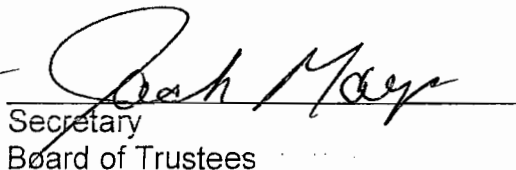
WHEREAS, the Murray Center has many volunteers serving the facility and programs at a cost savings to the State; and
