Dear Mr. Constantino

I am writing this letter to express my opposition to closing Murray Developmental Center. For the sake of the residents who live there and are in need of the vital support and high quality specialized medical care they get at M.D.C., I beg you to keep M. D. C. open.

I will give you an example for my opposition:

"Our daughter, Carol Jo Tucker (Fir Cottage) was placed in a state-approved private home by state workers for a week so we could get a much needed relief from the strenuous care required by Carol. My wife and I were at the point of nervous Breakdowns. When we went to get her at the end of the week, Carol was a nervous wreck – shaking all over and whimpering as though she had been abused. It took several weeks before we could get her back to her normal self.

Carol has the ability of a two to three-month old infant, although she is 57 years old. She is in diapers, doesn't chew her food, cannot speak, cannot express herself in any way, and she has the mental and physical ability of one who is only a few months old.

I feel no place except M.D.C. could give the quality of care Carol requires. The staff is familiar with the care that Carol needs and I couldn't give her the care she requires. I can barely take care of myself. I am alone, as my wife, Carol's mother, passed away on October 9, 2011. I will be 91 years old in November of this year. Carol could not survive in a group home, as she has no way of attending to her own needs – food, health, toileting, etc. She has such extreme needs and she would not have anywhere to go if M.C.D closed.

I am not thinking only of my daughter, but also about the caregivers, nurses, doctors, and other employed staff at Murray Developmental Center. They would all be out of work if the Center closes.

So, my reason for writing this letter is: Please, for the sake of the residents and staff, do not close Murray Developmental Center; as another state center would, no doubt, not be a choice.

To Whom It May Concern:

I am guardian of my brother, Wesley, who resides at Murray Center in Centralia, Illinois. Wes was born blind, profoundly mentally retarded, and has been diagnosed with Intermittent Explosive disorder and psychotic disorder. Luckily, Murray Center opened when he was around 10 years old and had started to toss furniture and become too much to handle at home. He is now 58 and one of the longest residing residents at Murray. The staff at Murray Center are his family and know him better than anyone. Although he is unable to communicate verbally, the staff at Murray can understand his wants and needs via his facial expression, body movements, vocalizations and gestures. They know what he likes and dislikes. They know his comfort zone and that as long as his routine remains the same he will not get agitated and his self-abusive behavior can be kept under control. They know that although he is blind, as long as everything is kept in the same place he can find his way around just fine. He has the mental age of a toddler so he depends on them for constant guidance with things like personal hygiene and grooming. He is on numerous medications which must be adjusted often. The staff at Murray take excellent care of him and he seems very happy at Murray: sitting in his favorite chair whistling, rocking, smiling and clapping his hands.

At his age, neither I nor the staff believe that he would be able to adapt to a new environment. I fear his inability to adjust would keep him in a constant state of confusion and uncontrollable behavior causing him to require constant constraint and heavy medication. I pray every day that Murray will remain open and my brother will not be forced out of his home.



Dear Members of the Health Facilities and Services Review Board,

I am the sister and guardian for Brian Megenity, a 51-year-old resident of the Murray Center in Centralia since 2004. My family and I are opposed to Project # 13-058 which seeks to close it. I am writing to communicate why it is so important to us that Murray be allowed to remain open.

Brian has been happier and more stable at Murray than in any other setting. Throughout his adult life he has had six different placements in Community Integrated Living Arrangements (CILAs). Each placement was fraught with very serious problems that required police interventions and/or hospitalizations. The only reason a sixth placement was attempted in 2008 is that Brian had made so much progress during his first four years at Murray Center, we felt it was time to give him another chance. But away from Murray, he rapidly regressed.

What we have learned from Brian's failed attempts at community living is that when he is away from the structure of a more secure setting, his anxiety spirals out of control. He becomes rageful and violent, and puts everyone in his environment at risk of harm. This pattern seems to be intensifying as he ages.

In 2008, when he was finally transitioned from the CILA back to Murray Center, he immediately stabilized. He settled back into the structure he needs in order to feel safe enough to sleep at night, and to cope with the various elements of daily living. Brian's moods and behaviors are handled with skill and respect there. They do not escalate to dangerous levels. In fact, he does not test the limits there the way he does in less secure settings. The stability of the setting and the support of the staff enable him to be involved in the community. He enjoys attending the Kaskaskia Workshop daily. He participates in outings to restaurants, movies, parks, etc.

In July and August 2008, it took several weeks to convince the Department of Human Services that Brian needed to return to Murray. During that time his behavior was threatening the safety of everyone in the CILA, and, because of the level of his violence, he was denied admittance to all nine area hospitals. We were terrified that before his return would be approved, he might seriously hurt or kill someone.

As you consider Project # 13-058, we ask that you think of Brian and the many others who receive excellent, individualized care at Murray. There are those who will be unable to function or get the care, security, and close monitoring they need in a CILA setting. Please deny the application to close Murray.



WHEREAS, said application asks for Board approval to proceed with the closure of Murray Center, a state operated developmental center (SODC); and


WHEREAS, such closure will negatively impact Murray Center residents access to necessary and appropriate levels of care; and







We are writing in **opposition to the closure** of the Murray Center. It is our desire that the Murray Center be kept open.



We are writing in opposition to Governor Quinn's proposed closure of Murray Developmental Center in Centralia, Illinois (Project # 13-058). As parents/guardians, we believe that the least restrictive/most appropriate placement for our son is Murray Center.

Geoffrey, now 46, has been at Murray since 1980; to him, Murray is home. Because Geoffrey has very little 'expressive language', it is difficult to accurately assess his functioning level; however, all tests over the years have consistently placed him in the 3½ - 5-year old range.

Living at Murray Center gives us the assurance that Geoffrey is safe and well taken care of; he requires 24-hour supervision for his personal safety and physical well-being. As with most 4-year olds, Geoff is not always aware of the inherent danger in his surroundings – traffic, wandering onto someone else's property, his inability to make his needs known verbally, or resolving conflicts with other residents who do not understand him.

While there may be many mentally and physical challenged individuals who are able to function in a less-restrictive environment than Murray, Geoffrey is not one of them.

He needs help on a daily basis taking care of his physical needs;

He is not able to function in a work environment, other than basic tasks in a sheltered workshop, such as the Kaskaskia Workshop, which he attends on a daily basis;

He cannot prepare a meal for himself, take care of his laundry, or attend to other basic personal skills.

In all periodic/annual evaluations of Geoffrey since his initial placement at Murray, staff has concluded (and we agree) that Murray Developmental Center is the least restrictive/most appropriate placement for Geoff. Deciding that all residents of Murray (or any other state facility) are capable of functioning in a community setting is no more logical than assuming that all individuals with cerebral palsy will respond satisfactorily to the same physical therapy regimen.

We do not support this closure project and urge you to deny the Department of Human Services application (Project # 13-058) to close Murray Developmental Center.
