### Illinois FY 2011 Rankings

- 42nd in total fiscal effort (down from 40th in 2009) -- this is a measure of state commitment to funding services with DD (page 16)
- 44th in community fiscal effort in FY 2011-- this measures how much the state spends in the community including residential settings for 15 or fewer people and other support services (family supports, supported employment, personal care)
- 50th in the % of people with I/DD in supervised residential settings for 1-6 people (see page 18)
- Only two other states (Texas and New Jersey) serve more people in state institutions than Illinois (page 24).
- 46th in spending "per capita" on the HCBS Waiver (page 35)
- 32nd supported living/personal assistance participants per capita (page 43)
- 38th supported employment workers per capita (page 50)
- 29th in spending per family (in family support programs) (page 55)
- 46th in # of families supported (in family support programs) per capita (page 55)
- Almost 35,000 people with I/DD living with caregivers over age 60 (estimated) – (page 59)

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
