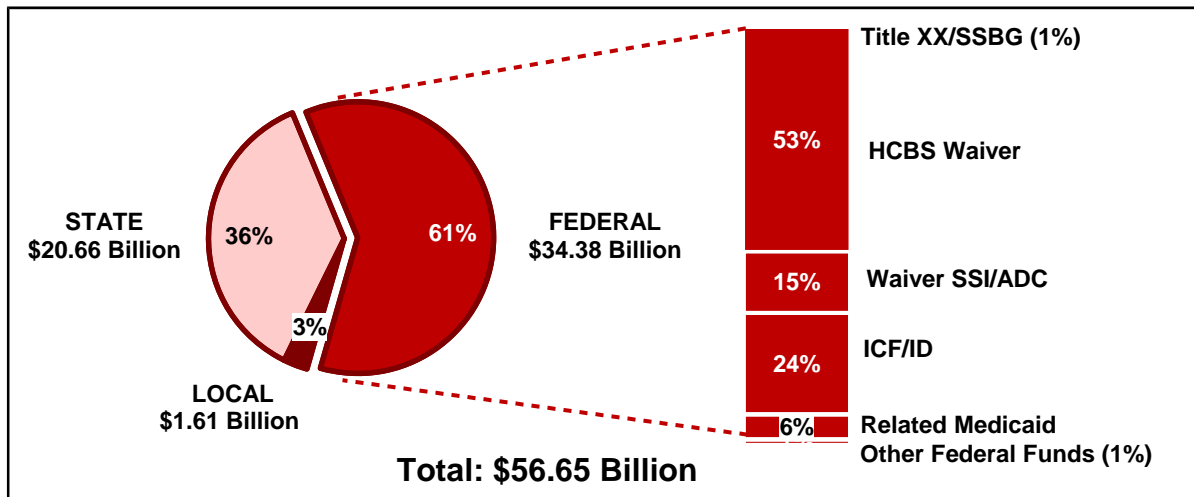
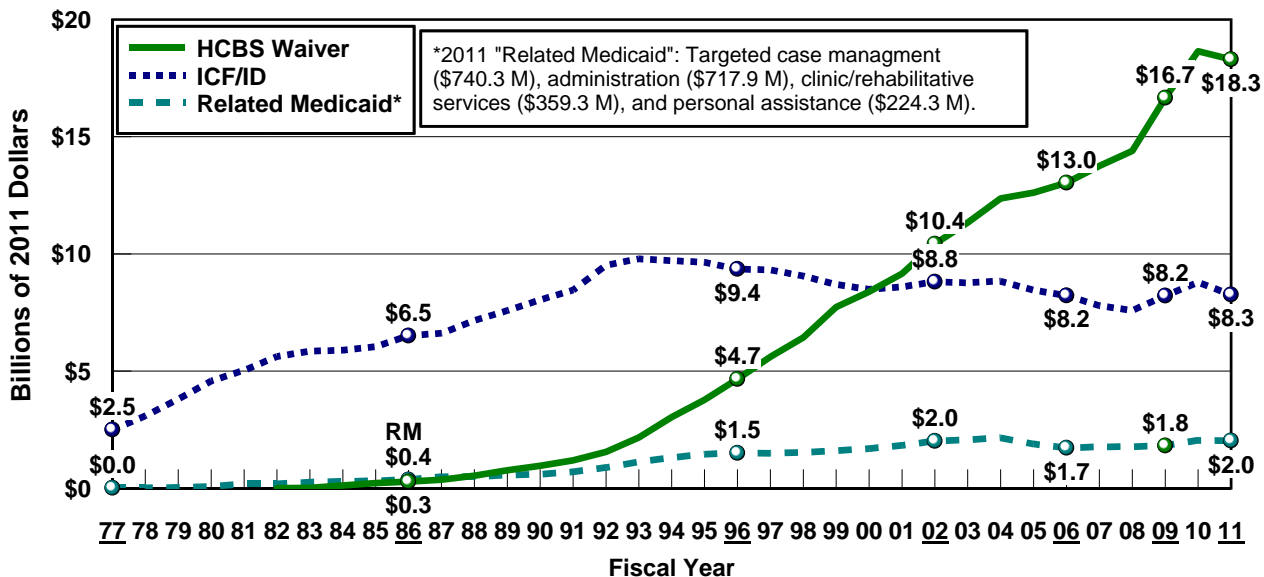

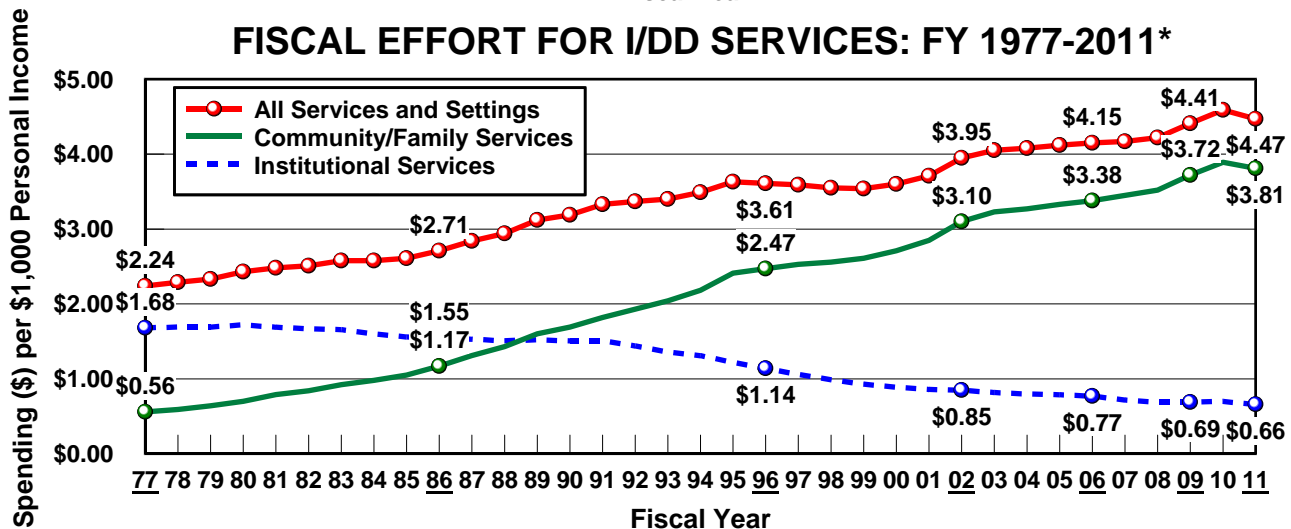
## TOTAL I/DD SPENDING BY REVENUE SOURCE: FY 2011

## FISCAL EFFORT FOR I/DD SERVICES: FY 1977-2011\*



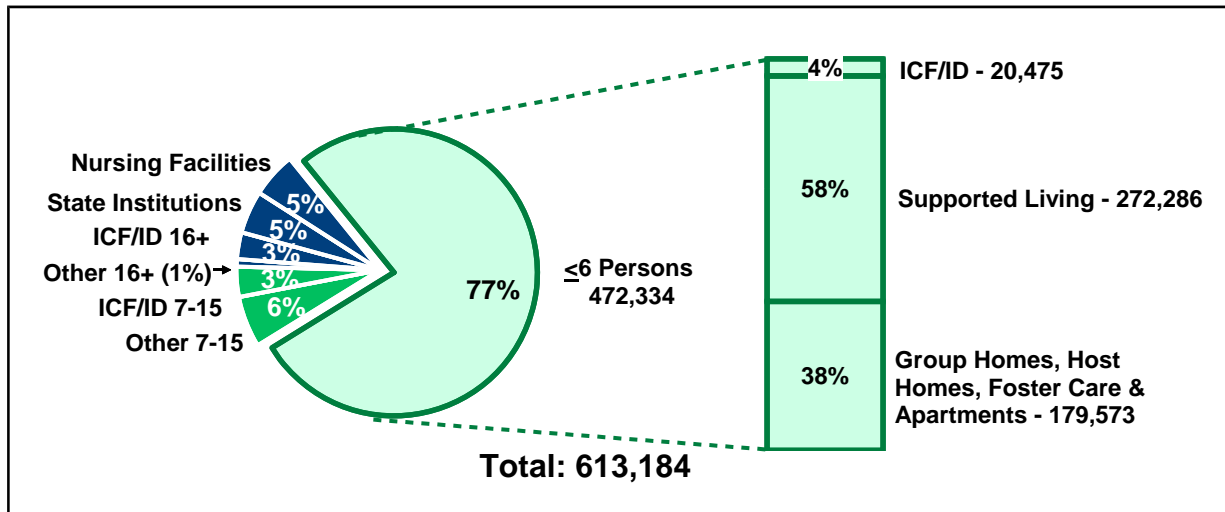
\*Fiscal effort is a measure of how much a state spends on I/DD services after controlling for state wealth.

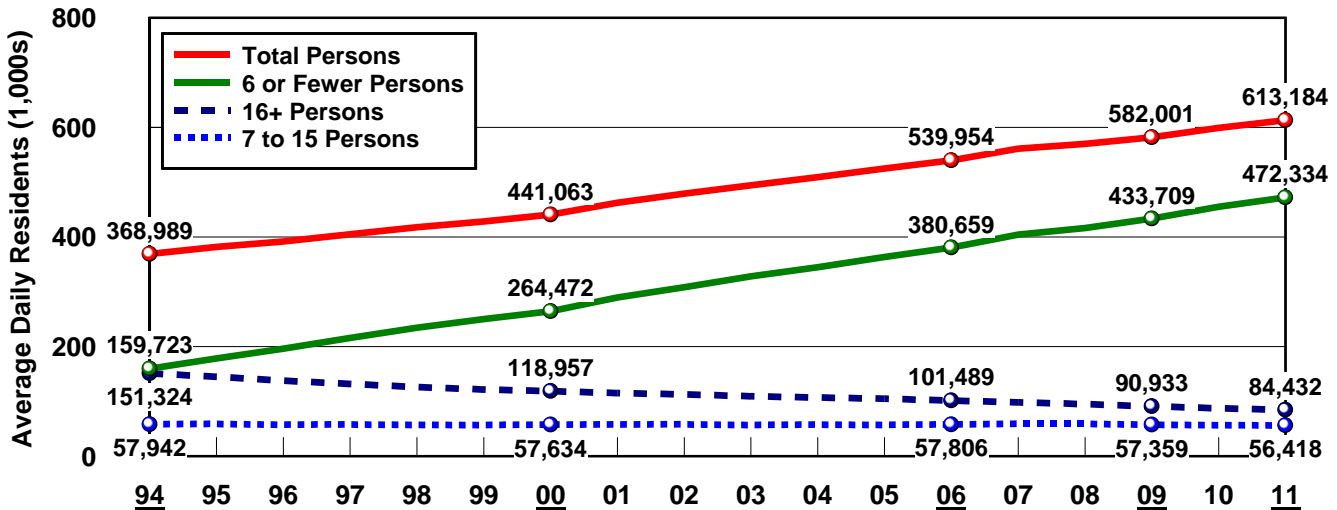

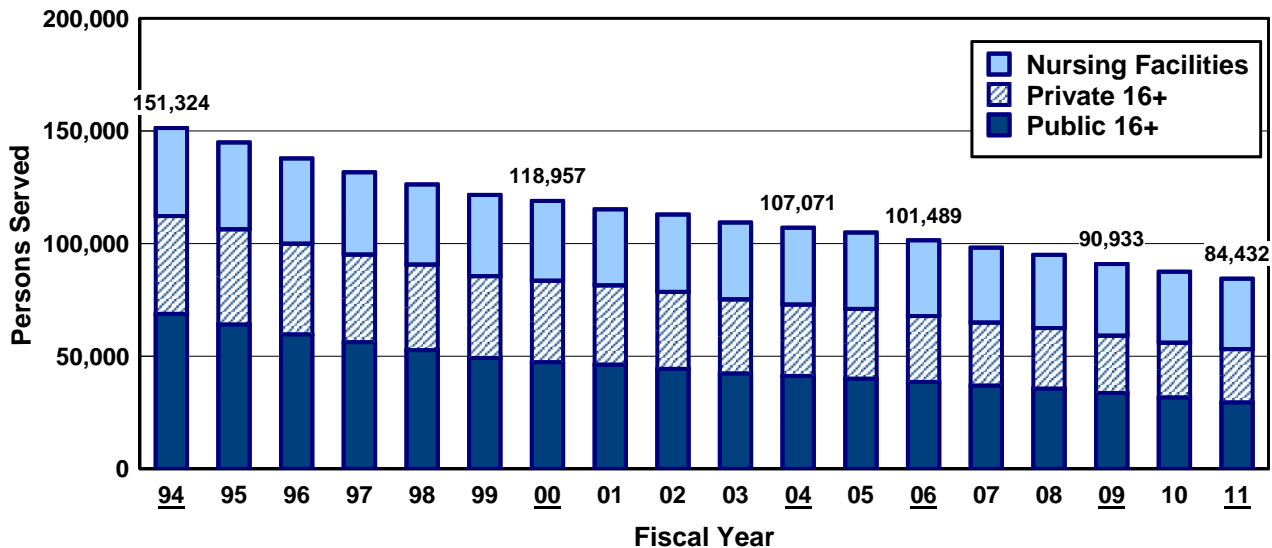
## PERSONS BY SETTING IN FISCAL YEAR: FY 2011



## PERSONS WITH I/DD BY SIZE OF SETTING: FY 1994-2011



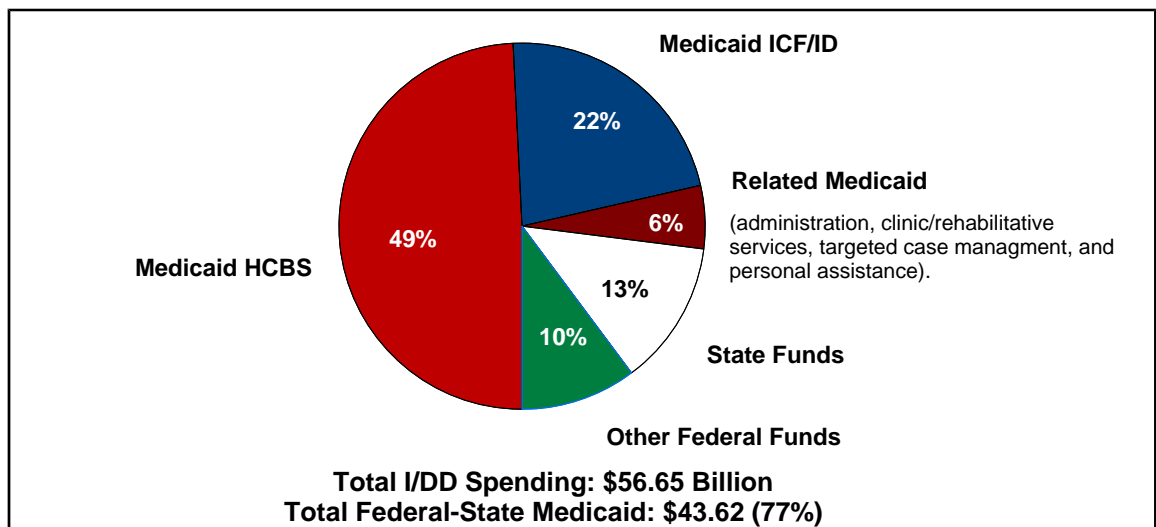
## PERSONS IN PUBLIC AND PRIVATE 16+ INSTITUTIONS: FY 1994-2011



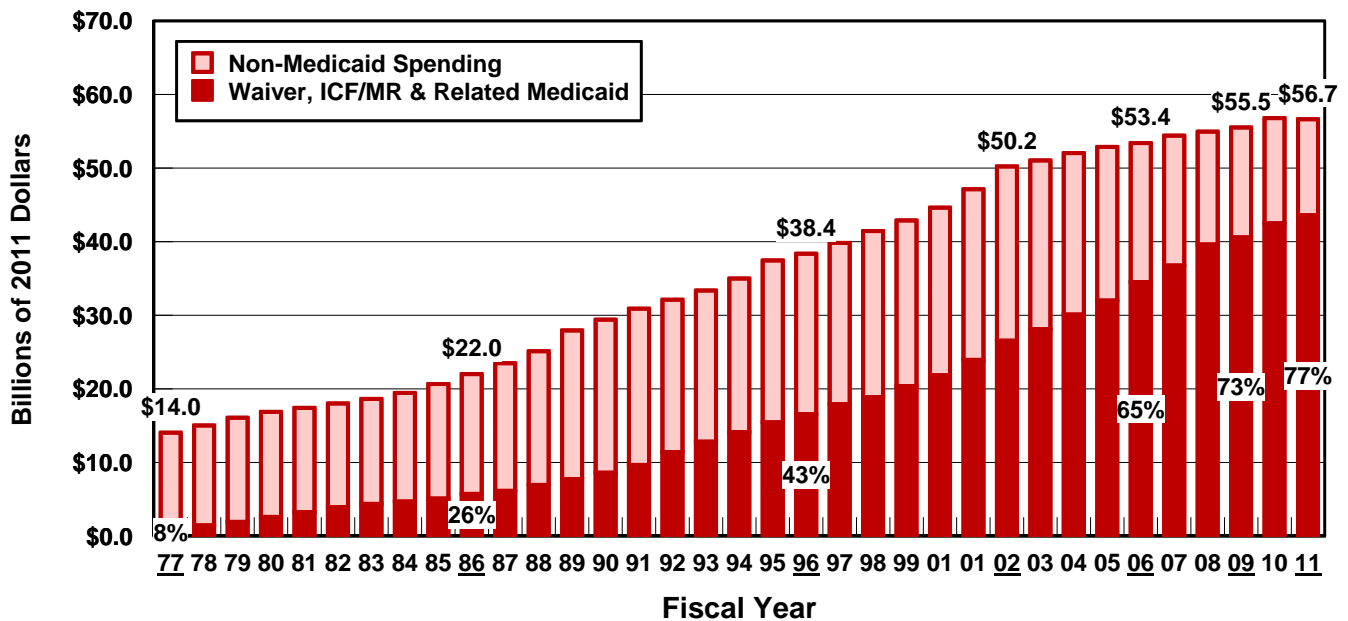

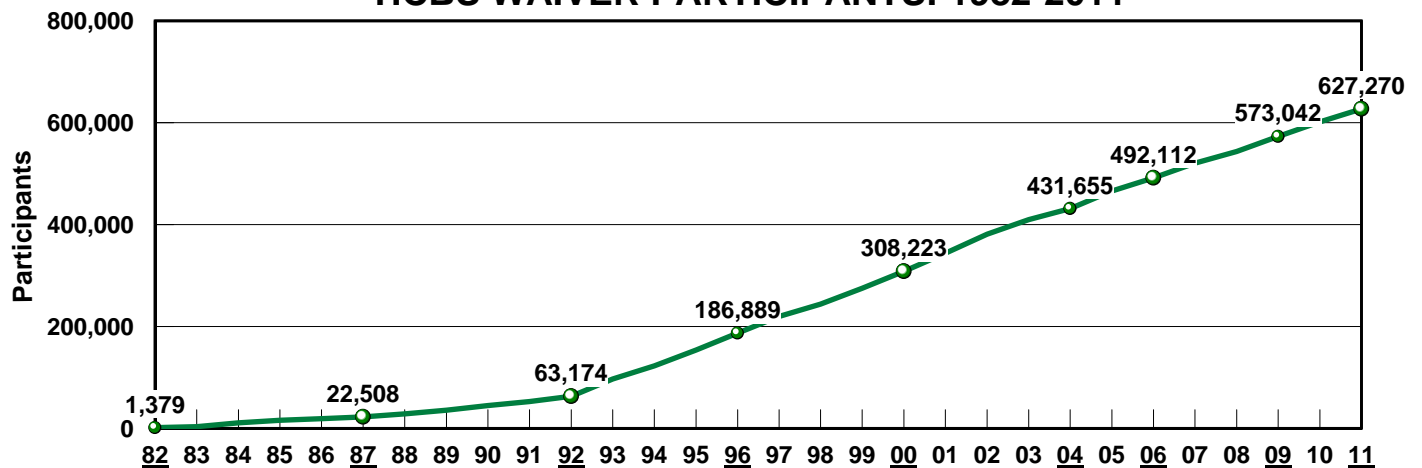
## MEDICAID IS 77% OF TOTAL I/DD SPENDING IN FY 2011

## HCBS WAIVER PARTICIPANTS: 1982-2011



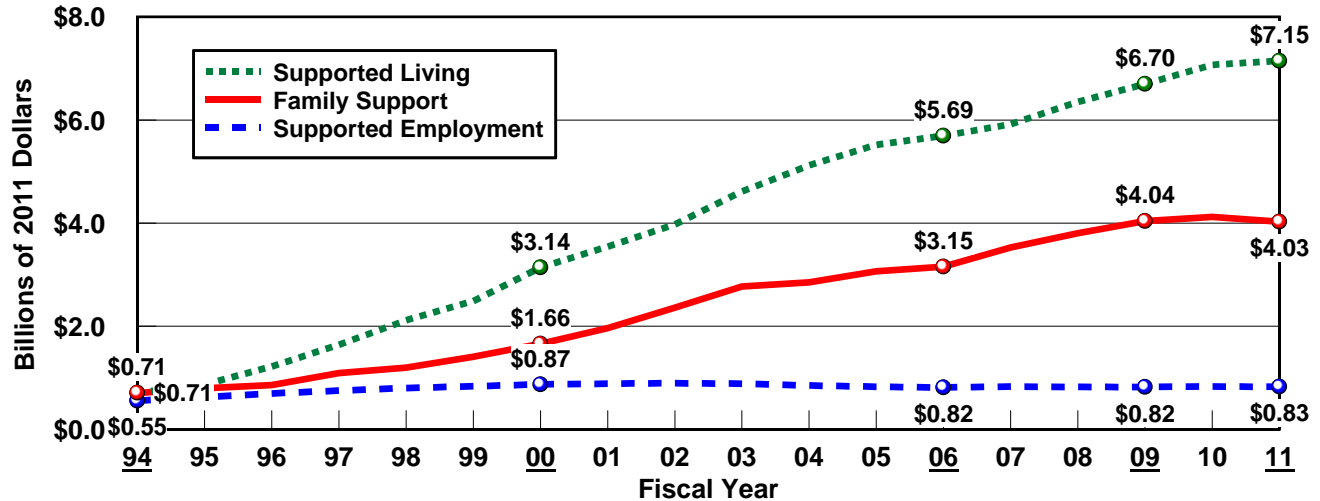

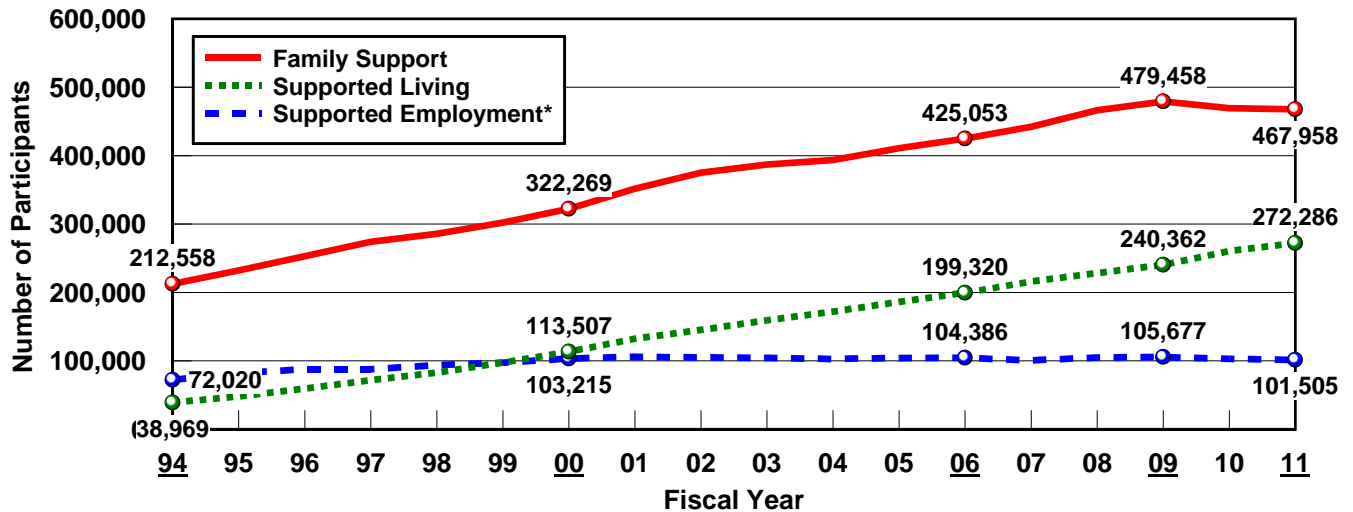

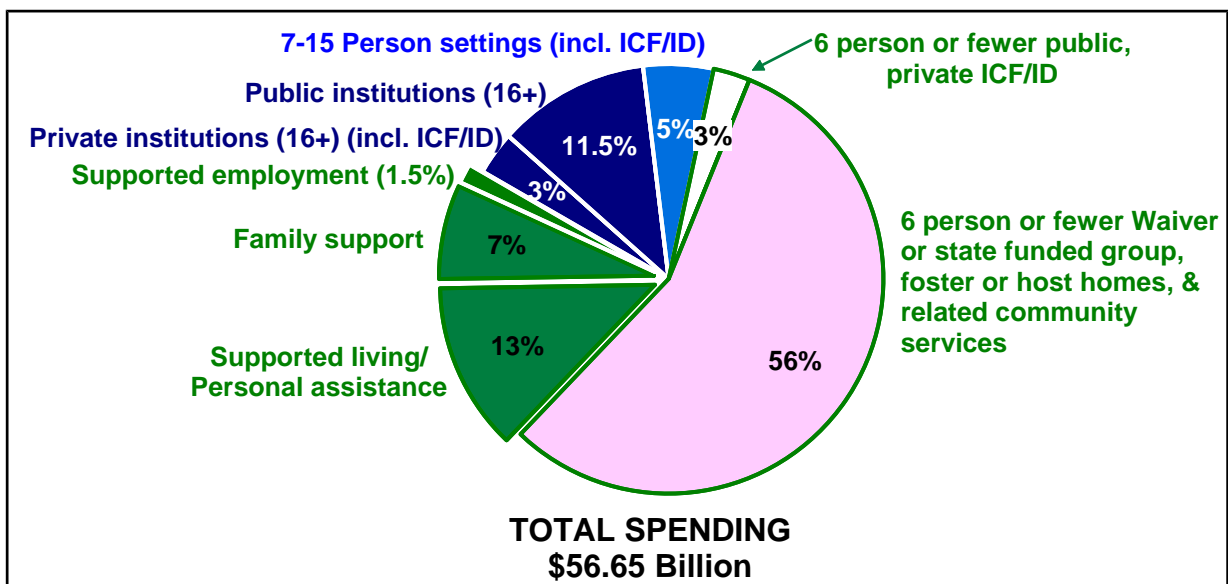

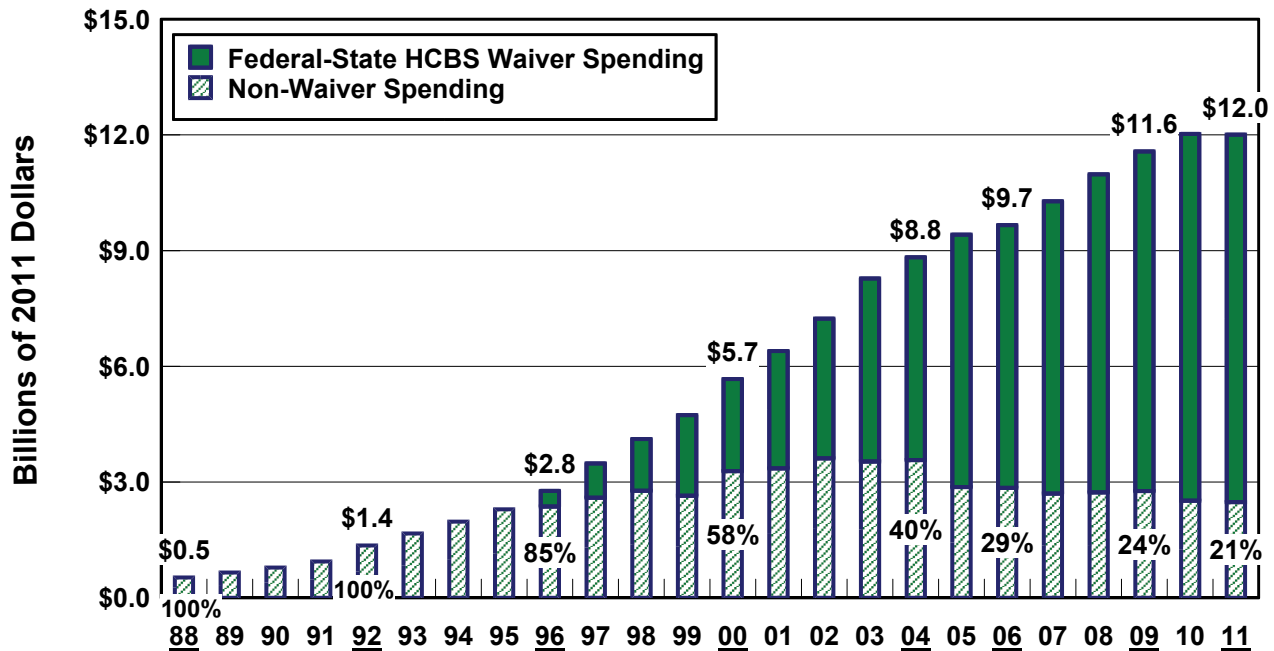

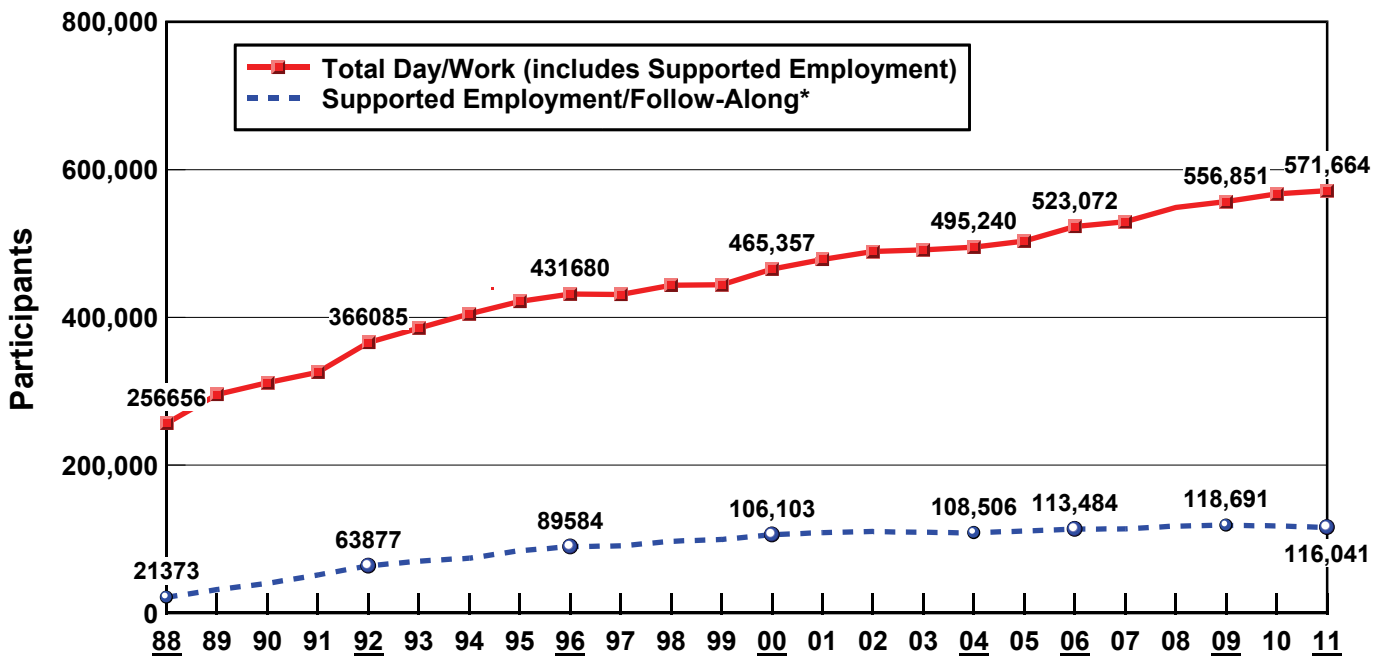

## SUPPORTED LIVING, FAMILY SUPPORT AND SUPPORTED EMPLOYMENT SPENDING: FY 1988-2011



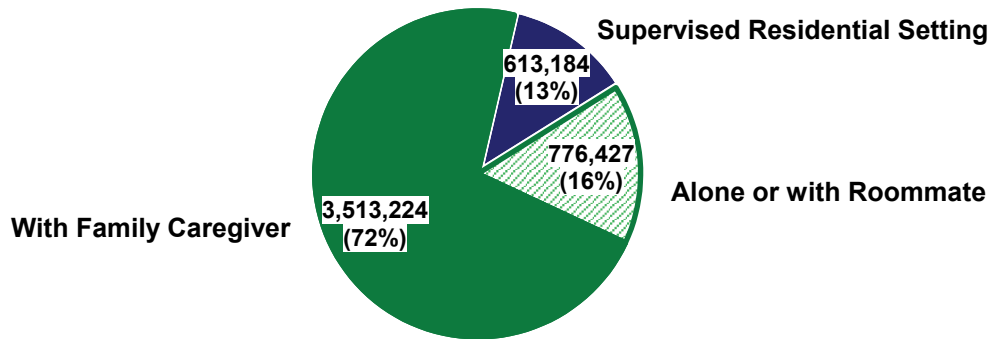
## DAY/WORK AND SUPPORTED EMPLOYMENT PARTICIPANTS: FY 1988-2011

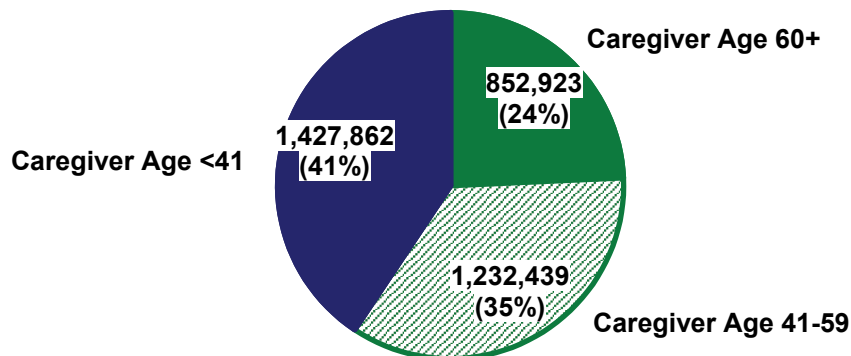
## ESTIMATED NUMBER OF INDIVIDUALS WITH I/DD BY LIVING ARRANGEMENT: FY 2011

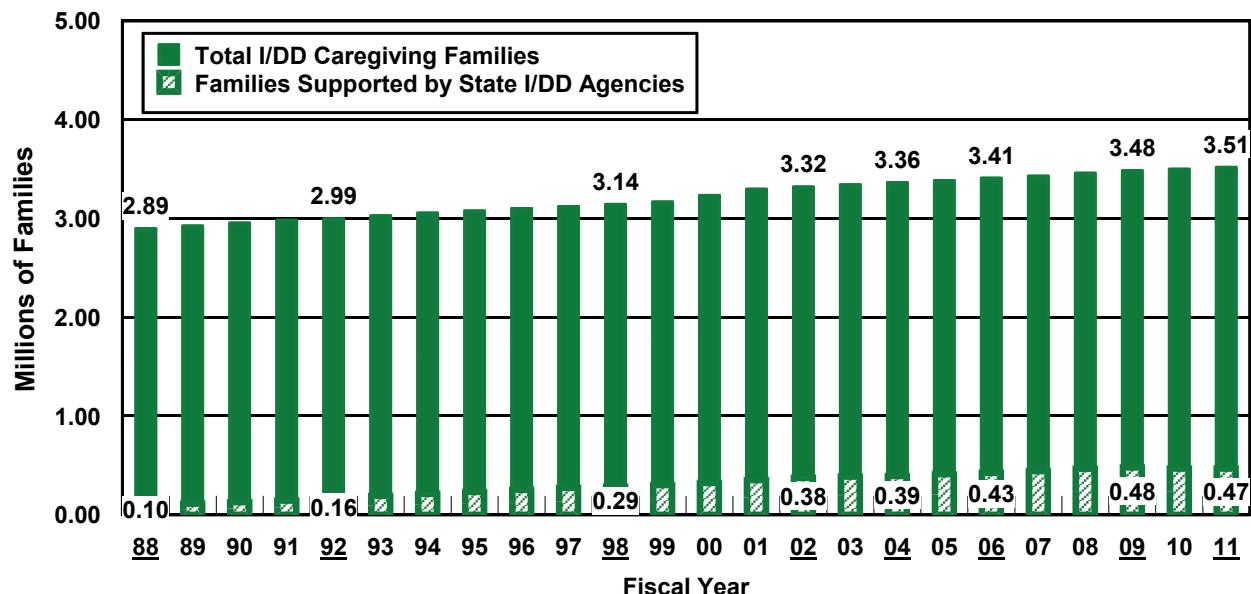
