This personal attention seems to be missing at larger hospitals.

Many have mentioned to me that if it wasn't for Jerseyville, they would have had their babies in the car or had serious complications when trying to get to other hospitals.

Jersey Community Hospital's redecoration and improvement to its OB department have made it, in my opinion, the nicest and most comfortable OB departments in this area.

Please consider not allowing this important part of our communities to be lost.
