• The project is before the State Board because the project proposes to discontinue a category of service under the jurisdiction of the State Board.

PURPOSE OF THE PROJECT:

• The purpose of the project is to discontinue a 20 bed long term care category of service because it is no longer economically feasible for the hospital, low patient census over the past 3 years, and an excess of 759 long term care beds in the HSA 3 long term care service area.

PUBLIC HEARING/COMMENT:

 A public hearing was offered on this project; however, no hearing was requested. State Board Staff have received no letters of opposition and no letters of support regarding this project.

FINANCIAL AND ECONOMIC FEASIBILITY:

• The proposed project will incur no costs.

CONCLUSION:

There is a calculated excess of 759 long term care in the HSA 3 service area. Given the current bed excess, and the low census in the long term care unit, it would appear that the proposed discontinuation is justified. The applicants have met the requirements of (77 IAC 1110.130 (a) (b) (c) – Discontinuation

I. The Proposed Project

The applicants (Taylorville Memorial Hospital, Memorial Health System) are proposing to discontinue a 20 bed long term care category of service at Taylorville Memorial Hospital. There is no cost to this project. **The anticipated project completion date is March 1, 2015.**

II. Summary of Findings

- A. The State Board Staff finds the proposed project appears to be in conformance with the provisions of Part 1110.
- B. Part 1120 is not applicable to this project because there is no cost.

III. General Information

The applicants are Memorial Health System and Taylorville Memorial Hospital. Taylorville Memorial Hospital is located at 201 E. Pleasant Street, Taylorville, Illinois in the HSA III Service Area and the Christian County Long Term Care Planning Area. The operating entity licensee is Taylorville Memorial Hospital and the owner of the site is Memorial Health System. Memorial Health System (Parent) is incorporated as a not-for-profit corporation under the laws of the state of Illinois and is a tax-exempt organization as described in Section 501(c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code (the Code). Memorial Health System and Subsidiaries (MHS) comprise the following corporations and their subsidiaries. Memorial Health System is the sole corporate member of

- Memorial Medical Center (MMC)
 - Memorial Medical Center Foundation (MMCF)
- Memorial Physician Services (MPS)
 - HealthCare Network Properties, LLC d/b/a Memorial Properties (MP)

HSA III consists of the Illinois Counties of Adams, Brown, Calhoun, Cass, Christian, Greene, Hancock, Jersey, Logan, Macoupin, Mason, Menard, Montgomery, Morgan, Pike, Sangamon, Schuyler, and Scott. There is no land acquisition cost for this project. This is a substantive project subject to a Part 1110. Project obligation will occur at the time of permit issuance, and the anticipated project completion date is March 1, 2015.

IV. Project Costs and Sources of Funds

There is no cost to this project.

V. Section 1110.130 - Discontinuation

A) Criterion 1110.130 (a) - Information Requirements

The applicants are proposing to discontinue a 20 beds long term care category of service at Taylorville Memorial Hospital. The anticipated date of discontinuation is March 1, 2015. The applicants are intending to use the vacated space for administrative purpose and storage. The medical records will be maintained at the hospital

B) Criterion 1110.130 (b) - Reasons for Discontinuation

There is an excess of 759 long term care beds in the Health Service Area 3. Over the past three years the facility had an average occupancy of 57.23%.

According to the applicants the Long Term Care service at Taylorville Memorial Hospital is no longer economically feasible and is impairing the facility's financial viability. The annual net negative financial impact of maintaining the Long Term Care unit exceeds \$1,000,000 per year

C) Criterion 1110.130 (c) - Impact on Access

There will be no impact on access as there is an excess of 759 long term care beds in the HSA 3 service area. As noted in Table Two below there are 33 long term care facilities within 45 minutes of Taylorville Memorial Hospital. The following facilities provided letters stating that they have sufficient capacity to accommodate the needs of all or a significant portion of Taylorville Memorial Hospital's historical caseload of patients requiring long-term care services. These facilities stated they can meet this need without restriction of limitations that would preclude us from providing long-term care services to residents of the Christian County market area.

VII. Safety Net Impact Statement

This discontinuation project will not have a material impact on essential safety net services in the community. The project will take 20 Long Term Care beds out of service in IDPH Health Service Area 3 where there is a calculated excess of 759 Long Term Beds according to the latest Inventory of Health Care Facilities and Services and Need Determinations Summary of General Long-Term Nursing Care Beds and Need by Health Service Area. Moreover, in the Christian County planning area where Taylorville Memorial Hospital is located, there is a calculated excess of 47 and in the four counties contiguous to Christian County, calculated excesses exist as follows;

Sangamon County - 43 excess LTC beds.

Montgomery County - 94 excess LTC beds.

Macon County - 79 excess LTC beds.

Shelby County - 52 excess LTC beds.

There are 33 facilities that provide Long-Term Care services located within 45 minutes travel time of Taylorville Memorial Hospital. The average daily census of the Taylorville Memorial Hospital Long -Term Care unit in Calendar Year 2012 was 11.4 patients. These 11.4 patients per day have ample access to other existing Long-Term Care beds in other 33 existing facilities located within 45 minutes travel time of Taylorville Memorial Hospital located in Christian, Sangamon, Montgomery, Macon and Shelby counties. As documented, all of the facilities that responded to the applicants request for letters describing the impact of the proposed discontinuation project on their facilities responded positively that the discontinuation would not have an adverse effect upon access to care for residents of the applicant's market area or negatively impact their facilities. All indicated that they have capacity to accept any patients referred to them in the future.

2. The project's impact on the ability of another provider of health care system to cross-subsidize safety net services.

This project will not have any impact on other providers or health care systems and, as such, it will not have any impact on other providers' or health care systems' abilities to cross-subsidize safety net services.

3. How the discontinuation of a facility or service might impact the remaining safety net providers in a given community.

This discontinuation project will not have a material impact on the remaining safety net providers in the community. The project will take 20 Long Term Care beds out of service in IDPH Health Service Area 3 where there is a calculated excess of 812 Long Term Beds according to the latest Inventory of Health Care Facilities and Services and Need Determinations Summary of General Long-Term Nursing Care Beds and Need by Health Service Area. Moreover, in the Christian County planning area where Taylorville Memorial Hospital is located, there is a calculated excess of 47 and in the four counties contiguous to Christian County, calculated excesses exist as follows
