My son was hospitalized at OSF Saint Anthony Medical Center and received excellent care during his critical time of need. He had a brain tumor removed and had to spend an extended time in a patient care room. The care was exceptional, however, the room was small, and there was no room for us to comfortably visit for the extended periods of time required during his stay. In addition, the room was shared with other patients during his stay and it was difficult to have any privacy. After brain surgery, my son was extremely sensitive to light, sounds, smells and movement. Being in a non-private room was not a good situation. I think Rockford area residents who choose OSF Saint Anthony for their care should not have to receive it in an outdated and cramped patient care room facility.

I urge you to approve the subject project application to build the bed pavilion at OSF Saint Anthony, in Rockford, IL, that will offer private rooms for future patients.
