I'm writing to express my personal support for the new campus proposal for Rockford Memorial Hospital. I wanted to share my personal experience about the expert care we received during the most frightening time in our lives, in hopes that it will help you cast a vote in support of the project as well.

My son Kamden started running a fever in October of 2013. We didn't think much of it at first, and neither did his pediatrician, but after a few days, it wouldn't go down even after taking Tylenol and Ibuprofen. Kamden also got a crazy looking rash, and became severely lethargic. It was then that I knew this wasn't just a "virus" and In the middle of the night, my husband and I rushed him in to the emergency room. It was there we were told that my son, who was only 2 years old at the time, had Kawasaki Disease. If you've never heard of it, you are not alone. It is extremely rare, and if it's not diagnosed and treated within the first 10 days of getting sick, the disease can be deadly. Kawasaki attacks your small and medium capillaries, and that it why it's so important that it be treated right away, so it doesn't damage the heart. The emergency room we went to referred us to Rockford Memorial for treatment because it was the only hospital in the region that knew how to treat people with Kawasaki Disease.

Kamden spent an entire week in the hospital while undergoing treatment for Kawasaki. He had to undergo not one, but two rounds of intravenous immunoglobulin or IVIG treatment. Doctors administer the medicine intravenously, over a 12 hour period. When I say it was a horrifying experience, that's putting it lightly. My husband and I were so afraid we would lose our little man. Finally after the second round of the IVIG, my son's fever broke and he started feeling better. The care we received at RMH was second to none. I cannot tell you how scared we were, but the doctors and nurses at RMH in the pediatric unit were so patient, loving and reassuring that our little guy was going to pull through this and be okay. It was so nice to be able to have his treatment close to home and not have to travel to Chicago or Madison. We live; work and play here, and it would have been an even more difficult experience to deal with if we would have had to get Kam's treatments out of town. Not only would we have to endure the stress of the Illness, but we would have had to find somewhere to stay, someone to watch out pets, check on our house and who knows what else while Kam was sick. My family fully supports the new campus propsoal because we know it's needed not just for the people who live in Rockford, but for

those who are sick from all over the region. Having access to the highest quality health care is something we all deserve, without having to travel out of town to receive it. I also feel that as a leader in pediatric care for the region that RMH deserves more modern facilities that are better designed for the future of medicine.

In October of 2014 I was diagnosed with breast cancer. The plan suggested by the medical team was surgery to remove the lump, followed by 30 radiation treatments. I had surgery on November 12, radiation began in January at the Cancer Center located in Rockford Memorial, and I am happy to report that I am doing well.

I am writing to support maintaining the West Side Campus, particularly the Cancer Center. After having surgery, I was given the option of receiving radiation at a facility closer to me. I chose to stay at Rockford Memorial for two reasons: the medical staff I had met with, and because I would be the first patient to receive treatments from the newly installed linear accelerator, which would allow me to receive the most effective treatment. Those of us who live in rural areas are accustomed to traveling some distance to meet with specialists, but hope that travel time can be kept to a minimum. Extended travel time is a hardship for patients and families physically, financially, and emotionally, and I appreciated that the Cancer Center, less than an hour away, had the latest equipment and highly trained staff available to me. I was also told that many patients schedule their radiation treatments either during their lunch hour or immediately after work. This convenience causes minimal disruption in the work and/or family schedule. It would not be possible if the provider were farther away. I am pleased that a state-of-the art Cancer Center will continue to treat patients at the Rockton Avenue location, and that all primary care and specialty physicians currently providing care there will continue to provide services.
