**EXEMPTION APPLICANT(S):** Northwestern Memorial HealthCare, KishHealth System, Kishwaukee Community Hospital, Valley West Community Hospital, The Midland Surgical Center, LLC

**FACILITY NAME and LOCATION:** Kishwaukee Community Hospital, Dekalb, Illinois, Valley West Community Hospital, Sycamore, Illinois, The Midland Surgical Center, Sycamore, Illinois

#### 1. The Transaction

On August 17, 2015 the State Board received three change of ownership exemption applications for the two (2) hospitals and the surgical center identified above. Northwestern Memorial HealthCare is proposing to become the sole corporate member of KishHealth System. KishHealth System controls Kishwaukee Community Hospital, Valley West Community Hospital, and The Midland Surgical Center. Northwestern Memorial HealthCare will have the power and authority to govern, direct, and oversee the property, funds, business, and affairs of KishHealth System. This transaction will result in change of control of KishHealth's existing health care facilities. The operating entities/licensees will remain unchanged. The enterprise range of value for KishHealth System was concluded to be in the range of \$329.1 million to \$362.4 million.

There is no anticipated acquisition price for this transaction; however, as of the closing, there will be a fund created with the unrestricted net cash position of the KishHealth System at closing. This fund will be used exclusively to support the mission of KishHealth and benefit the health care needs of KishHealth's geographic service area. The anticipated completion date is December 31, 2015.

#### 2. The Applicants

The applicants are Northwestern Memorial HealthCare, KishHealth System, Kishwaukee Community Hospital, Valley West Community Hospital, The Midland Surgical Center, LLC.

Northwestern Memorial HealthCare, located at 251 East Huron Street, Chicago, Illinois, is the corporate parent of Northwestern Memorial Hospital, Northwestern Lake Forest Hospital, Northwestern Medical Group, and Northwestern Memorial Foundation. Northwestern Memorial HealthCare is also the parent of CDH-Delnor Health System (Central DuPage Hospital and Delnor Community Hospital). Northwestern Memorial Hospital has a total of 894 licensed beds in the Feinberg/Galter Pavilion and Prentice Women's Hospital. It is the primary teaching hospital for Northwestern University's Feinberg School of Medicine. The University's Feinberg School of Medicine is integrally linked with Northwestern Memorial Healthcare through a shared strategic plan.

<u>KishHealth</u>, based in DeKalb, Illinois, is a community-owned health system with facilities in DeKalb, Sandwich, Sycamore, Plano, Genoa, Hampshire, Waterman, and Rochelle, including the Physician Group, a multi-specialty practice with over 40 health care providers with several office locations.

<u>Kishwaukee Hospital</u>, located at 1 Kish Hospital Drive, DeKalb, Illinois, is a 98-bed acute care hospital. In 2011, the Joint Center opened at Kishwaukee Hospital, and in 2013, a Spine Center was added. Kishwaukee Hospital is a not-for-profit organization that provides comprehensive health care services, including inpatient acute and nonacute care and various outpatient services to residents of DeKalb County, Illinois and surrounding areas. Kishwaukee Hospital owns a 74.5% interest in Midlands Surgical Center, LLC a for-profit entity.

<u>Valley West Community Hospital</u> a 25 bed Critical Access Hospital located at 1302 North Main Street, Sandwich, Illinois is a not-for-profit organization that provides comprehensive health care services including inpatient acute and nonacute care and various outpatient services, to residents of DeKalb, Kendall, and LaSalle counties of Illinois and surrounding areas.

<u>The Midland Surgical Center</u>, LLC is a multi-specialty ambulatory surgical treatment center located at 2120 Midlands Court, Sycamore, Illinois. Kishwaukee Community Hospital owns 74.5% of this surgery center.

#### 3. Public Hearing

Three (3) public hearings were held on September 24, 2015 in DeKalb, Illinois for these changes of ownership exemption applications. State Board Chair Kathy Olson was the State Board representative at these public hearings.

At the public hearing for Exemption #E-007-15, twenty (20) individuals registered for the public hearing, five (5) individuals provided supporting testimony and four (4) individuals provided neutral testimony. Exemption #E-008-15 five (5) individuals provided supporting testimony and one (1) individual provided neutral testimony. Exemption #E-009-15 five (5) individuals provided supporting testimony. Letters of support and opposition were received by the State Board Staff.

#### 4. Public Act 99-0154

Public Act 99-0154 became law July 29, 2015 and is effective immediately. This Act states that an application for a change of ownership need not contain a signed transaction document so long as the application contains the following:

- name and background of the parties
- structure of the transaction

- person who will be the licensed or certified entity both prior to and after the transaction
- fair market value of assets transferred
- purchase price or other consideration for the assets

The State Board cannot impose any conditions or restrictions, including;

- the time period for a subsequent change of ownership; or
- a commitment to continue to offer a service for a specified period of time after the change of ownership occurs.

20 ILCS 3960/6 (b) states "an exemption shall be approved when information required by the State Board by rule is submitted."

#### The applicants have submitted the required information per PA 99-0154.

A no objection letter was received from the Office of The Attorney General and is included at the conclusion of this report.

#### 5. Other Information

Attached to the end of this report is the 2014 Hospital Profiles for Kishwaukee Community Hospital, Valley West Community Hospital, and The Midland Surgical Center.

We have reviewed the charitable trust aspects of the proposed affiliation of KishHealth System and Northwestern Memorial Health Care. In conducting our review, we have considered not only the information and documentation provided to us by KishHealth and Northwestern Memorial Health Care but also the parties' agreement to amend the bylaws of Kishwaukee Health Foundation to add a new provision which will state as follows:

"Any unrestricted gifts that are held by Kishwaukee Health Foundation as of the effective date of the affiliation between KishHealth System and Northwestern Memorial Health Care will continue to be used consistent with Kishwaukee Health Foundation's charitable purposes, specifically for the benefit of the populations and communities served by KishHealth System prior to its affiliation with Northwestern Memorial Health Care."
