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I had worked as the Medical Director of a hospital up in your area for the better part of two decades, and although I have moved offices to the western suburbs, I still maintain nearly a thousand active patients from the north shore suburbs including Northbrook, Wheeling, Glenview, Highland Park and Deerfield and Northfield. Currently, when my patients from these areas require hospitalization, they must travel long distances to receive it, sometimes even into the city where they may be housed with populations that are quite dissimilar to them. It would be highly preferable to have inpatient care available in or near their own community. The northern suburbs of Illinois, including Northbrook and beyond, have had a lack of appropriate beds for their geography, and a psychiatric hospital in this area is long overdue.

I fully support this project and urge you to support the approval of US HealthVest's behavioral hospital and thank you for your assistance in providing access to care.

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
