Pursuant to 77 Illinois Administrative Code 1130.760, this is the annual progress report for project # 16-032, Rush Oak Brook Orthopaedic Center (the "Project"). The Permit for the Project was issued on October 25, 2016, to Rush Oak Brook Orthopaedic Center, LLC and Rush University Medical Center (jointly the "Permit Holders"). The approved Permit amount was \$65,341,612 for the development of a medical clinics building. The Permit Holders provide the following information regarding the progress of the Project:

- 1. Current Status of the Project—Through October, 2017 to date the Project is 30% complete. The scope and size of the Project have not changed per permit issuance.
- 2. Costs Incurred to Date-- Project costs incurred through October, 2017 to date are \$19,883,000. The Permit Holders anticipate the total project costs at completion will be consistent with those reported in the approved CON application.
- 3. Obligation of Project—The Project has been obligated via commitment of at least one-third of the projected project costs.
- 4. Method of Financing the Project—The Project has been financed using cash and mortgages, in accord with the permit.
- 5. Anticipated Date of Completion—The anticipated completion date of the Project is June 1, 2019, consistent with that identified in the CON application; and there has been no change to the scope of the Project.
