Current status of the project, including the percentage of the project finished, components
finished and components yet to be finished, and any changes in the scope of the project and
size:

The building has the steel frame completed and the concrete floors have been poured. The contractor has begun enclosing the structure and is constructing the exterior canopies. The interior framing is underway, and the electrical and mechanical rough ins are currently inprogress.

The excavation work is completed on the parking deck and the foundatians are underway.

The light remodel work in the hospital has begun and is currently 10% completed. The remaining construction of the building is yet to be completed.

Ta date, there are no identified changes in project scope or size.

\$12,548,306 has been spent through 12/31/2017 and 26% of the project is complete.
