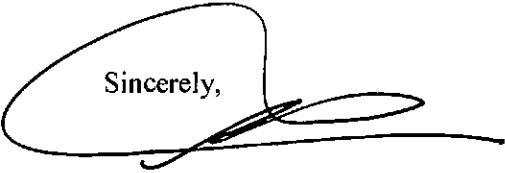
Dear Mr. Constantino:

As advised by Senior Vice President and COO, Sue Ripsch, via July 27, 2016 letter to you, the six additional NICU stations approved through the above-referenced Certificate of Exemption ("COE") became operational on July 27, 2016.

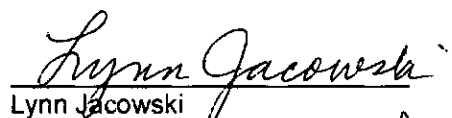
The projected project cost, as identified in the COE application was \$500,000; all of which was identified as the cost of equipment to be purchased. A total of \$499,251.18 was expended for equipment, with no other capitalized costs incurred. In addition, and as identified in the COE application, funding of the project was through cash. The incurred expenditure identified above represents the total capitalized cost required to complete the project, and no additional costs or expenditures are anticipated.

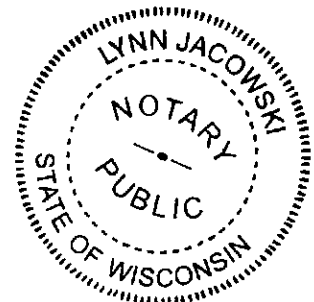
