Dear Mr. Constantino:

This Affidavit supplements the previous Affidavit I prepared and submitted on January 18, 2017, a copy of which is attached as Exhibit A.

I am writing to express my strong support for the joint effort by Silver Cross Hospital & Medical Centers ("Silver Cross Hospital") and US Healthvest LLC ("US Healthvest") to construct and establish a 100 bed behavioral health hospital (to be known as Silver Oaks Hospital) on the Silver Cross Hospital Campus.

As I previously stated, I have worked at Advocate South Suburban Hospital for the past four years. At Advocate South Suburban Hospital, we treat at least 80 to 100 patients a month, who are in need of mental health services and/or substance abuse resources. Approximately 85% of these patients are in need of inpatient psychiatric services. Since Advocate South Suburban Hospital does not offer that level of care, our patients are transferred to another hospital.

At Advocate South Suburban Hospital, we do not track the zip codes of the patients that we transfer out to other hospitals for inpatient psychiatric services. However, it is my professional opinion that all of the transferred patients came from the zip codes surrounding Silver Cross Hospital.

If the Illinois Health Facilities and Services Review Board authorizes Silver Cross Hospital and US Healthvest to construct and establish Silver Oaks Hospital, it is my professional opinion that Advocate South Suburban Hospital will refer between 68 and 85 patients per month to Silver Oaks Hospital for inpatient psychiatric care.

Dear Ms. Avery,

I am writing this letter in support of the Certificate of Need application for a 100-bed behavioral hospital in New Lenox, IL through the joint venture between Silver Cross Hospital and US HealthVest.

As a Clinical Psychologist and President at Plainfield Counseling Center, LLC located in Plainfield, Illinois my patients have experienced frequent delays in accessing inpatient psychiatric care mainly due to bed shortages. There have been many times patients have had to wait to access care leading to poor outcomes in their mental healthcare.

Plainfield Counseling Center, LLC is not DHS-funded. On a yearly basis our Center serves approximately 1,200 different individuals and many more whom we refer out to other community resources due to being overcapacity and not accepting new patients. Within a 12-month period, I would expect our Center to refer to the proposed facility at least 75 of our patients who need inpatient level of care and refer many more who call in to our Center whom we are not able to service. Our patients reside in and are coming from the following areas: Plainfield – 60544, 60585, 60586; Joliet – 60403, 60410, 60421, 60431; Shorewood – 60404, 60435, Mokena -60448; Crest Hill – 60403, 60441; Wilmington 28401, 28402, 28403.

The information I have included has not been used to support another pending or approved CON application for a behavioral hospital.

I urge you to support the approval of certificate of need application for Silver Oaks Hospital. Approval of the application will increase access to these important services in our area.

If the Illinois Health Facilities and Services Review Board authorizes Silver Cross Hospital and US Healthvest to construct and establish Silver Oaks Hospital, it is my professional opinion that Morris Hospital & Healthcare Centers will admit the same number of, or even more, patients to Silver Oaks Hospital than the cases set forth above on an annual basis.
