## STATE BOARD STAFF REPORT PERMIT RENEWAL REQUEST

### **I. Background**

On November 21, 2017, the State Board approved Project #17-017. The permit authorized the establishment of a 12-station End Stage Renal Dialysis (ESRD) facility on the campus of Provident Hospital of Cook County, in Chicago. The State Agency notes the project is not obligated, and the current project completion date is December 31, 2018. Project cost: \$2,238,268.

State Board Staff notes the permit holders submitted the permit renewal request on December 17, 2018. This submittal was **not** in accordance with 77 IAC 1130.740(d), which states that the State Board must receive renewal requests at least 45 days prior to the permit expiration date. A \$500.00 permit renewal fee, and a \$500.00 late fee accompanied the renewal request.

### **II. Findings**

State Board Staff notes this is the first renewal request for this project and the permit holders have submitted all of the information required in Section 1130.740 for a permit renewal.

### III. The Permit Renewal Request

- A. Requested Completion Date: The permit holders request a project completion date of December 31, 2019. This would extend the project's completion date twelve months, from December 31, 2018 to December 31, 2019.
- B. Status of the Project and Components Yet to be Finished: The permit holders state the project is approximately 1% complete, with all construction and IDPH inspection/certification/licensure remaining.
- C. Reason(s) Why the Project Has Not Been Completed: The permit holders' state the project has experienced delay resulting from a higher-priority construction project in the hospital pharmacy that required completion before the ESRD facility construction could commence. An RFP for construction of the dialysis facility has been released for bids, and the permit holders expect to begin construction once a viable bid is received.
- D. Evidence of Financial Commitment to Fund the Project: The permit holders indicate that none (0%) of project funds have been expended to date, and can attest to the existence of sufficient financial resources to complete the project.
- E. Anticipated Final Cost of the Project: The permit holders estimate the project will not deviate from the original permit amount of \$2,238,268.

### IV. Project Description & Other Background Information

The permit authorized the establishment of a 12-station ESRD facility on the campus of Provident Hospital of Cook County, in Chicago. Project cost: \$2,238,268.

**V. Applicable Rules for Permit Renewal Requests**

77 IAC 1130.740 specifies that a permit holder may request a change in the approved project completion date by applying for a permit renewal.

77 IAC 1130.230(h)(5) states that failure to complete a project or to renew a permit within the prescribed timeframes will subject the permit holders to the sanctions and penalties provided in the Act and this Subpart.

77 IAC 1130.740(b) states that a permit renewal will commence on the expiration date of the original or renewed completion period.

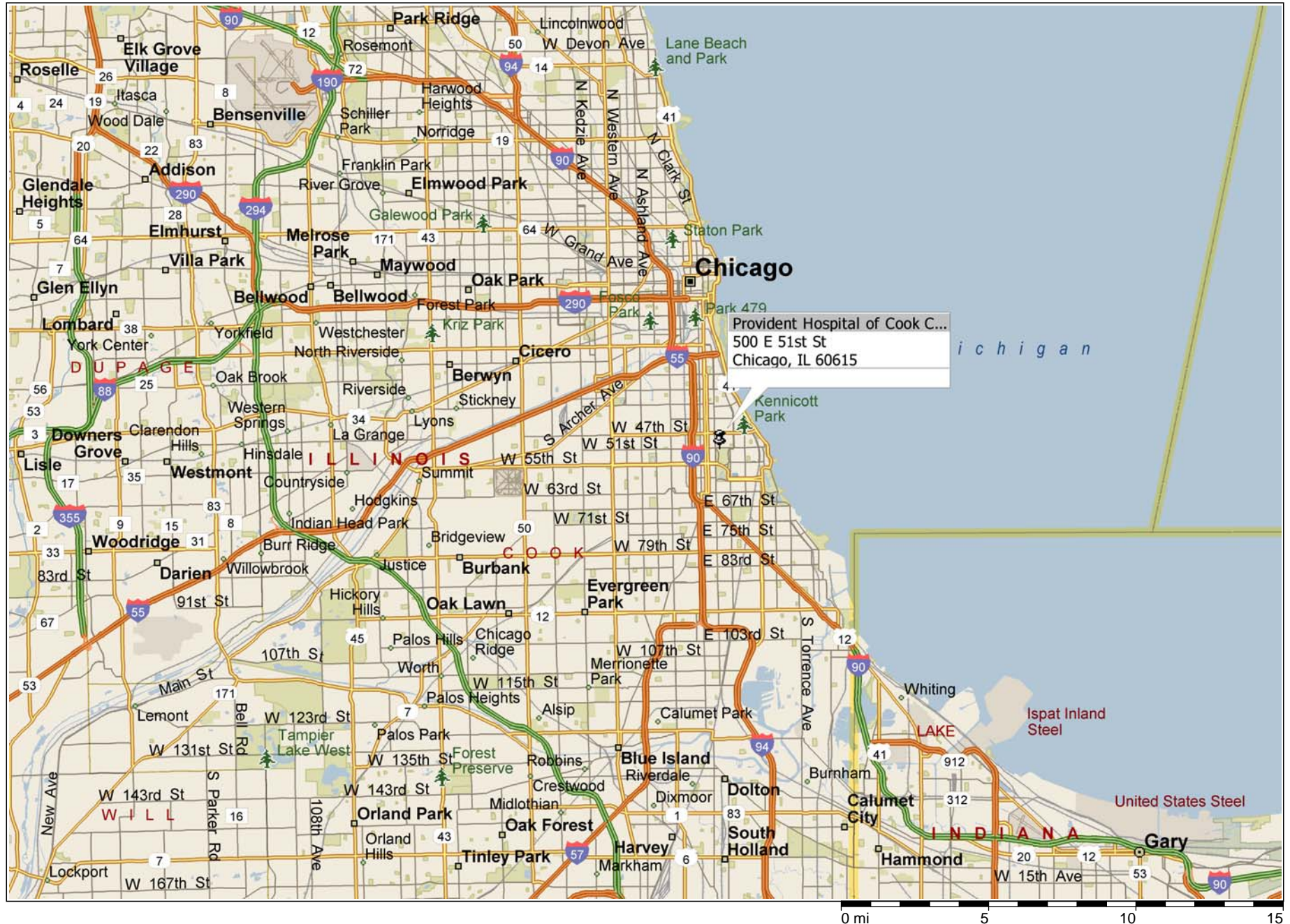
77 IAC 1130.740(c) states that the State Board must be in receipt of a permit renewal request at least 45 days prior to the expiration date of the completion period, and include the following: 1) the requested completion date; 2) a status report on the project detailing what percent has been completed and a summary of project components yet to be finished and the amount of funds expended on the project to date; 3) a statement as to the reasons why the project has not been completed; and 4) confirmatory evidence by the permit holders' authorized representative that the project's costs and scope are in compliance with what the State Board approved and that sufficient financial resources are available to complete the project.

77 IAC 1130.740(d) states the State Board staff will review the request and prepare a report of its findings. If the findings are that the request is in conformance with all HFSRB criteria, and if this is the first request for this project, then the request, staff's findings, and all related documentation shall be sent to the Chairman. The Chairman, acting on behalf of HFSRB, will approve, deny or refer the request to the HFSRB for action. If staff finds that all criteria are not positive or, if this is not the first request for this project, or if the Chairman refers this to HFSRB for action, then HFSRB will evaluate the information submitted to determine if the project has proceeded with due diligence (as defined in 77 IAC 1130.140). Denial of a permit renewal request constitutes HFSRB's Notice of Intent to revoke a permit and the permit holders will be afforded an opportunity for an administrative hearing.

The above-referenced project was approved by the State Board on November 21, 2017; and proposed the establishment of a 12-station ESRD facility on the hospital campus.

The completion date for the project, as identified in the *Application for Permit* is December 31, 2018; and the Permit holders respectfully request that the completion date be extended to December 31, 2019. This extension, we believe, will provide sufficient time to complete the project, and prepare and file a final project report consistent with the State Board's rules.

As of the writing of this letter, the project is approximately 1% complete, and approximately \$ 0.00 of the \$2,238,268 approved project cost has been expended.

The initiation of the project was delayed due to delays in construction of the pharmacy, which needed to be completed prior to beginning the construction portion of the dialysis project. An RFP for the construction of the dialysis facility, which will occupy the space vacated by the pharmacy is currently out for bid.

The anticipated project costs and the scope of the project remain consistent with those approved by the State Board, and the funds required for the project remain available.
