I am a board- certified physician in internal medicine providing inpatient and outpatient care to my patients at Advocate Condell Medical Center. I am writing today to express my support for the Certificate of Need (CON) request for approval to build a 60-bed inpatient rehabilitation hospital, Encompass Health Rehabilitation of Libertyville, LLC. In my role as a practicing internist, I see the need on a daily basis for intensive inpatient rehabilitation for patients who have suffered a stroke, brain bleeds, cerebral tumors, spinal cord tumors, amputations, traumas and neurological conditions. These patients deserve this service to not only have the opportunity to achieve the very best outcomes but also the highest quality of care.

In my role as a physician, my work goes beyond supervising my patients. Inpatient rehabilitation is critically important for this population of patients. The availability of advanced technology, advanced education and training for the physicians, nurses, and therapists and evidence-based rehabilitation medicine is paramount in the patient's road to optimal recovery and function.

In my 20-plus years as an internist in Lake County, I've learned and experienced that this service is limited or access is denied by others facilities that do offer inpatient rehabilitation. Since Vista Health System closed their Inpatient Rehabilitation Unit, patients and families are traveling over 40 miles to the City of Chicago or further to receive this care. When the patients do get approved and transferred to an inpatient rehabilitation bed, I never see these patients back for follow-up care in my practice. I can't emphasize enough the importance of patients receiving continuity in their healthcare, both as inpatients and outpatients, close to home. Our patients in Lake County and surrounding counties certainly deserve to have all of their healthcare needs met, including inpatient rehabilitation, close to home.

In summary, I am supporting and request the approval of the CON for Encompass Health Rehabilitation Hospital of Libertyville, LLC.
