Dear Mr. Skowron:

On August 6, 2019 the Illinois Health Facilities and Services Review Board (State Board) approved your request for the discontinuation of the two bed intensive care bed category of service at Warner Hospital and Health Services, 422 West White Street, Clinton, Illinois. The approval was based upon the application's compliance with applicable provisions of 77 IAC 1130.500 and 77 IAC 1130.525. The expected completion date is August 7, 2019. Upon approval Warner Hospital and Health Services will have 21 medical surgical beds and 2 pediatric beds for a total of 23 acute care beds.

You are reminded that this exemption is for the discontinuation of a category of service, and that you are to provide the State Board with a notice of the completion of the transaction no later than 90 days following the project completion date. Failure to provide the required notification shall subject the exemption holder to the sanctions provided under Section 14 of the Illinois Health Facilities Planning Act.

The State Board's approval does not exempt the transaction from any other regulatory, certification or licensure requirements that may be applicable. The exemption will be invalid should the facility for which the change of ownership was granted cease to be an existing health care facility as defined in 77 IAC 1130.140.
