This letter serves as written notice acknowledging Schwab Rehabilitation Hospital and Care Network's Discontinuation of the Category of Service for the unit identified as *Sub-Acute Skilled Nursing Unit (3S)*. These services formally ended on December 10, 2019 based on the approval of the Illinois Health Facilities and Services Review Board (State Board).

Effective Monday, March 9, 2020, the unit (3S) will be open to admissions as a Comprehensive Inpatient Acute Rehabilitation Unit, with a total of 12 beds. The unit will focus on treating patients primarily with spinal cord injuries, as well as, other conditions approved under CMS guidelines.
