3	Thank you for participating in today's public
4	hearing for Northwestern Memorial Hospital,
5	Chicago.
6	I am Courtney Avery, Administrator, and
7	Hearing Officer for the Illinois Health
8	Facilities and Services Review Board. Present
9	with me today is Ann Guild, Compliance Manager.

11	MS. GUILD: On behalf of HFSRB, thank
12	you for attending today's proceedings.
13	As per the rules of the Illinois Health
14	Planning Act, the previously published legal
15	notice - Notice of Review and Opportunity for
16	Public Hearing and Written Comment; and Public
17	Hearing and Opportunity for Written Comment
18	have been submitted to the court reporter and
19	will be included in today's record:

2	the modernization and the expansion of the
3	medical surgical and intensive care beds at
4	Northwestern Memorial Hospital, 251 East Huron
5	Street, Chicago. The project cost is
6	\$77,607,985.

8	by the Illinois Health Facilities and Services
9	Review Board pursuant to the Illinois Health
10	Facilities Planning Act. The hearing is open
11	to the public with opportunity to present
12	relevant verbal and written comments on the
13	proposed project.

22	Hearing none, today's proceedings will
23	begin with a representative from Northwestern
24	Memorial Hospital. Thank you.

1	MS. ORTH: This is for Project 20-011,
2	the Galter Bed Project.
3	Good morning. I'm Bridget Orth,
4	O-R-T-H, director of regulatory planning for
5	Northwestern Medicine. Northwestern Medicine
6	looks forward to moving ahead with our proposed
7	addition of beds in the Galter Pavilion on the
8	downtown campus of Northwestern Memorial
9	Hospital.
10	Northwestern Medicine continues to
11	invest across the Chicagoland area to provide
12	improved access to health care for all of the
13	communities we serve. This includes
14	investments in our facilities, our clinical
15	offerings, our community partnerships, and our
16	people. The project is a wonderful example of
17	that investment, providing improved access, as
18	well as additional jobs for our community. To
19	see how Northwestern Medicine is making a
20	difference throughout the region, you can visit
21	the Community Partnership Program link on the
22	nm.org website.
23	The COVID-19 pandemic has demonstrated
24	once again the need for continued investment in

1	health care infrastructure and flexible
2	capacity. This is on top of what we already
3	know about the ramifications of capacity
4	constraints at Northwestern Memorial Hospital,
5	including challenges that limited bed capacity
6	presents for access to our Emergency
7	Department.
8	We look forward to our review by the
9	Health Facilities and Services Review Board on
10	June 30th. Thank you.
11	HEARING OFFICER AVERY: Okay. We can go
12	off the record for this conversation.
13	(An off-the-record discussion was held.)
14	MS. IGOE: My name is Anne Igoe, and I'm
15	the health systems director at SEIU Healthcare
16	which represents 1,200 workers at Northwestern
17	Memorial Hospital.
18	As a critical stakeholder, we are
19	concerned about Northwestern Medicine's plan
20	over \$100,000 million on two new construction
21	projects.
22	While we agree with NM's decision to
23	expand its ICU service at NMH (after multiple
24	warnings from IDPH about abusing ED bypass), we

1 fear that NMH management will not adequately 2 staff the new beds. 3 NMH consistently understaffs its ED and 4 ICU and fails to fill vacant positions in a 5 timely fashion. 6 We assert that unless NM commits to 7 safely staff the new ICU beds and to promptly 8 fill all vacancies in the ED and ICU, the NMH 9 will continue to struggle with capacity and be forced to continue turning away hospitals at 10 11 higher rate than any other hospital in the 12 Chicago area. 13 As the union that represents the employees at Northwestern and specifically the 14 15 housekeepers, we are all too aware of the 16 problems around short staffing. Northwestern 17 continues to staff to have a skeleton staff and 18 supplements with temporary workers. Over the 19 past year, vacancies in the housekeeping 20 departments have been upwards of 20 to 25 2.1 percent of the department, placing a burden on 22 current employees, resulting in over 50,000 23 hours of overtime and work done by temporary 24 employees.

1	Building additional beds is great, but
2	cleaning the beds is the problem and
3	Northwestern has yet to show it will fill its
4	vacancies and adjust its starting wages to
5	address the high turn over in the department.
6	Starting wages in the housekeeping department
7	just increased to \$15.25, a mere \$1.25 over the
8	minimum wage in just two weeks.
9	We also believe that NMH needs to commit
10	to treating more Medicaid patients as a
11	condition of our support for the ICU expansion.
12	According to IDPH, only 7.4 percent of
13	Northwestern Medicine patients were on Medicaid
14	in CY 2018. And at their flagship hospital,
15	Northwestern Memorial Hospital, the percentage
16	was only 20 percent.
17	Despite this meager percentage, NMH
18	receive tens of millions in annual Medicaid
19	subsidies intended for safety-net hospitals
20	under the Illinois Hospital Provider
21	Assessment. Yes, Northwestern Medicine treats
22	the largest number of Medicaid Patients in the
23	state, but as percent of its overall care, the
24	number is less than impressive. For

1	comparison, University of Chicago, also an
2	Academic Medical Center, has a payer mix of 42
3	percent.
4	We are here today to discuss the
5	expansion of ICU beds at Northwestern that
6	will, in theory, open up more beds in the ER so
7	that the days spent on bypass is reduced.
8	Currently, the ER is on diversion 30 percent of
9	the time. That is 30 percent of the year
10	ambulances that come from all over the city do
11	no have the option of stopping at Northwestern.
12	When looking at utilization of the ER by ZIP
13	code, we can see what that four neighborhoods,
14	Chatham, South Shore, Kenwood, and Roseland,
15	are amongst the higher utilizers of the
16	hospital and ER. It is these communities that
17	are affected when the hospital goes on bypass,
18	but also when the hospital makes decisions
19	about where to locate additional facilities and
20	follow-up care.
21	SEIU Healthcare believes that NM should
22	commit to increase its Medicaid Inpatient
23	Utilization Ratio (MIUR) as a condition of
24	approval of this project.

1	Should NM agree to address ongoing
2	staffing concerns and to increase MIUR, we
3	offer our conditional support for the NMH ICU
4	expansion.
