Dear Illinois Health Facilities and Services Review Board members,

I am writing in support of the newly proposed Sarah Bush Lincoln Bonutti Clinic (Effingham Medical Office Building #20-030).

I am Greg Taylor and oversee the management of all our medical practices. In all, Sarah Bush Lincoln employees 180 physicians and advanced practice providers throughout our 10-county service area. We were among the first hospitals in the region to employ medical staff and its proven to be a good strategy for us. We have been successful because we have an open dialogue with our medical staff, listen to their concerns, purchase technologically advanced equipment so they can provide the best care, and we are involved in the communities in which we have established services.

When we announced this \$35 million replacement medical office building in early August, the community embraced the project. Through social media comments, the story was shared 148 times. When HSHS announced it had filed for a public hearing to object to the project, the news was shared another 54 times. Lastly, the Effingham Daily News wrote an editorial last week supporting the project. Each time this project has been in the news, the community's comments have been overwhelmingly positive and supportive of the new Sarah Bush Lincoln Bonutti Clinic. I have attached copies of the stories and associated social media comments.

I was shocked and surprised to learn HSHS St. Anthony was opposing the project through a public hearing and soliciting community support to oppose it as well. This beautiful building welcoming travelers, guests and residents on its main northern entrance is nothing more than a doctor's office building. The architectural plans are clear. The SBL Bonutti Clinic is busting at the seams. We are consolidating some of our other established medical practices in Effingham in this proposed building, which accounts for the larger building. If we have learned anything through this pandemic, we have learned the value of social distancing. We incorporated separate reception areas for the various medical practices and added space for social distancing and to enhance patient confidentiality.

Please accept this letter as an indication of my full support of Effingham Medical Office Building #20-030.


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
