The Mercy Foundation currently has approximately \$4.0M unrestricted and \$3.4M restricted.

Mercy will continue to use the Mercy Foundation funds consistent with donor intent and when possible to support Mercy Hospital through closure as well as the Mercy Care Center. To the extent that donations cannot be used consistent with donor intent, Mercy and Mercy Foundation will seek to return such funds to the donor or obtain donor approval to use the funds for other charitable purposes on the Southside of Chicago. No funds will revert to Trinity Health for use other than as described. Mercy Foundation will eventually be wound down and dissolved.
