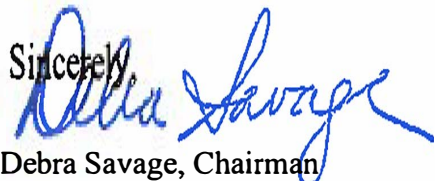
Dear Ms. Friedman:

On April 7, 2020, the Chairman of the Illinois Health Facilities Planning Board (State Board) acting on behalf of the State Board under 77 IAC 1130.560(b) approved your request for a change of ownership exemption. The approval was based upon the application's compliance with applicable provisions of 77 IAC 1130.520. The exemption is for Barrington Pain and Spine Institute. The entity to be licensed is Barrington Pain and Spine Institute, LLC.

The exemption involves a change of control of a licensed health care facility with no change in the licensed entity. The fair market value of the assets is \$18,000,000.

To demonstrate completion of this transaction, the exemption holder must provide the State Agency with the date that the ownership change occurred and also provide a copy of the license or certification issued pursuant to the change of ownership. Failure to provide the required notification shall subject the exemption holder to the sanctions provided under Section 14 of the Illinois Health Facilities Planning Act.

The State Board's approval does not exempt the transaction from any other regulatory, certification or licensure requirements that may be applicable prior to acquisition. The exemption will be invalid should the facility for which the change of ownership was granted cease to be an existing health care facility as defined in 77 IAC 1130.140.
