Dear Mr. Morado:

On September 17, 2020, the Chairman of the Illinois Health Facilities and Services Review Board (State Board) acting on behalf of the State Board under 77 IAC 1130.560(a) approved your request for the discontinuation of the 36-bed long-term care category of service. Additionally, the Applicants have been approved to add 20 medical surgical beds. The approval was based upon the application's compliance with applicable provisions of 77 IAC 1130. The exemption for discontinuation is for Rush Oak Park Hospital, 520 South Maple Avenue, Oak Park, Illinois. As result of this discontinuation the Hospital has the following categories of service and number of beds.

You are reminded that the issuance of the certificate of exemption is contingent upon the submittal of a statement to the State Board within 90 days of the closing date of the transaction that certifies the discontinuation has been completed in accordance with the key terms contained in the application. To demonstrate completion of this transaction, the exemption holder must provide the State Board with the date that the discontinuation occurred. Failure to provide the required notification shall subject the exemption holder to the sanctions provided under Section 14 of the Illinois Health Facilities Planning Act.

The State Board's approval does not exempt the transaction from any other regulatory, certification or licensure requirements that may be applicable.
