On April 9, 2021, the Chairman of the Illinois Health Facilities and Services Review Board acting on behalf of the State Board approved the referenced project. This approval was based upon the substantial conformance with the applicable standards and criteria in the Illinois Health Facilities Planning Act (20 ILCS 3960) and 77 Illinois Administrative Codes 1110 and 1120.

The permit approval authorizes the discontinuation of Kindred Chicago Central Hospital, a 95-bed Long-Term Acute Care Hospital, located at 4058 West Melrose Street, Chicago, Illinois.

This permit is valid only for the defined construction or modification, site, amount, and the named permit holder and is not transferable or assignable. In accordance with the Planning Act, the permit is valid until such time as the project has been completed, provided that all post permit requirements have been fulfilled, pursuant to the requirements of 77 Illinois Administrative Code 1130 and may result in an invalidation of the permit, sanctions, fines and/or State Board action to revoke the permit.

The permit holder must submit a written notice of project completion as defined in Section 1130.140. **The project must be completed by December 31, 2021,** the date specified in the permit application, unless a permit renewal has been obtained in accordance with the provisions of Section 1130.740. Permit renewal requests must be in writing and submitted at least 45 days but nor more than 90 days prior to the project's scheduled completion date. For projects having a cost, the certification of project completion must contain a report of final realized costs as specified by Section 1130.770.

This permit does not exempt the project or permit holder from licensing and certification requirements, including approval of applicable architectural plans and specifications prior to construction.
