Dear Mr. Kniery:

Advocate Illinois Masonic Medical Center is pleased to submit to you our annual progress report on the Project referenced above in accordance with requirements of the 77 Ill. Adm. Code 1130.760. The Project is for construction of a 4-story Center for Advanced Care (CAC) building expansion attached to the Hospital's Center for Advanced Care (CAC) and a 5-story Bed Tower (including the penthouse) on top of the existing and expanded CAC. This project discontinues 38 Medical/ Surgical beds, 20 Obstetric beds, 12 NICU beds, 5 AMI beds and adds 4 Intensive care beds.

The Review Board granted the permit for this Project on June 8, 2022.

### 1. Current status of the Project

Obligation: The Project was obligated on August 2, 2022 by signing a construction contract with Turner Construction Company obligating 44% of the permit value.

Percentage of the project finished: the Project is approximately 46% complete.

# Changes in scope and size:

On August 8, 2024, the Chairwoman of the Illinois Health Facilities and Services Review Board (State Board) acting on behalf of the State Board approved an alteration to the above-mentioned project to modernize/expand services on the campus of Advocate Illinois Masonic Medical Center, Chicago. The alteration approved the following:

- The addition of a normal newborn nursery with 10 bassinets.
- 2. The decrease in Neonatal Intensive Care (NICU) beds from 22 to 19.
- The addition of 5 centralized dialysis stations in the new Bed Tower, on the Medical/Surgical floor (7<sup>th</sup> floor)
- Transition of 3 Medical/Surgical beds from the new Bed Tower to the 8<sup>th</sup> floor of the Stone Building.

#### **Commitment of Funds:**

• As of April 30, 2025 56% of the total funds assigned to the project costs were committed to be expended by signed contracts.
