Dear Mr. Morado:

On May 2, 2024, the Illinois Health Facilities and Services Review Board (HFSRB) approved the permit holder's request for a permit renewal for the above-referenced project. This letter confirms the approval and issuance of a renewal to the above-referenced permitted project. Therefore, the permit for this project has been renewed through December 31, 2025.

If the permit holder determines that they will be unable to complete the project on or before December 31, 2025, the permit holder may request another renewal of the permit. Pursuant to Ill. Admin. Code tit. 77, §1130.740, request for permit renewals must be requested before the project completion date and must be received by HFSRB **AT LEAST 45 DAYS PRIOR TO THE EXPIRATION DATE OF THE PERMIT**.

Projects that are not completed within the time frame allowed under a valid permit shall expire and become invalid unless renewed by HFSRB, pursuant to a request submitted in accordance with Ill. Admin. Code tit. 77, §1130.740.

The permit holder is solely responsible for maintaining a valid permit and must comply with all post-permit requirements contained in the relevant parts of Title 77 of the Illinois Administrative Code, including without limitation, Subpart G of Part 1130.
