

**NOTICE OF AN OPPORTUNITY FOR PUBLIC COMMENT
AND REQUEST FOR PUBLIC HEARING**

In accordance with the requirements of the Illinois Health Facilities Planning Act, notice is given of the receipt of an application for exemption for a change of ownership of Midwestern Regional Medical Center a/k/a Cancer Treatment Centers of America, Chicago, 2520 Elisha Avenue, Zion, Illinois [#E-040-22]. The Applicants are Midwestern Regional Medical Center, LLC, Midwestern Regional Medical Center, Inc., City of Hope, COH HoldCo, Inc., and City of Hope. This transaction is considered a conversion of the current licensee from a for-profit limited liability company to a not-for profit corporation resulting in the issuance of a license to an entity different from current licensee.

This exemption application was called substantially complete on **August 1, 2022**. Written requests (no emails or faxes will be accepted) for a public hearing must be received by the Illinois Health Facilities and Services Review Board no later than **August 15, 2022**.
