On September 28, 2022, the Chairwoman of the Illinois Health Facilities and Services Review Board ("State Board") acting on behalf of the State Board approved the change of ownership of the real estate housing Joliet Surgery Center Limited Partnership d/b/a AmSurg Surgery Center, 998 129th Infantry Drive, Joliet, Illinois. This approval was based upon the substantial conformance with the applicable standards and criteria in the Illinois Health Facilities Planning Act (20 ILCS 3960) and 77 Illinois Administrative Codes 1130.

The licensee is Joliet Surgery Center Limited Partnership d/b/a AmSurg Surgery Center., a for profit entity and the owner of the site is Flagship CPT Joliet, LLC. The surgery center has been approved for the following surgical services: Dermatology, Gastroenterology, General Surgery, Laser Eye Surgery, OB/Gynecology, Ophthalmology, Orthopedic, Otolaryngology, Pain Management, Plastic Surgery, Podiatry, and Urology.

You are reminded that this exemption for change of ownership in which the applicant submitted key terms of the transaction, certification that the transaction was or was not completed according to the key terms contained in the application. The exemption holder must submit the certification within 90 days after the closing date of the transaction. To demonstrate completion of this transaction the exemption holder must provide the State Board with the date that the ownership change occurred and provide a copy of the license or certification issued pursuant to the change of ownership.

Failure to provide the required notification shall subject the exemption holder to the sanctions provided under Section 14 of the Illinois Health Facilities Planning Act. The exemption holder is also reminded that 77 Il. Adm. Code 1130.140 defines transactions that constitute a change of ownership of a health care facility. You should become familiar with those definitions.

The State Board's approval does not exempt the transaction from any other regulatory, certification or licensure requirements that may be applicable prior to acquisition. The exemption will be invalid should the facility for which the change of ownership was granted cease to be an existing health care facility as defined in 77 II. Adm. Code 1130.140.
