Pursuant to Section 1130.760 of the Illinois Health Facilities and Services Review Board ("HFSRB") rules, I am writing on behalf of Hoosier Care, Inc. d/b/a Exceptional Care and Training Center. (the "Permit Holder") to submit the annual progress report for its certificate of need permit to establish an 85-bed MC/DD facility to be located in Sterling, Illinois (the "Project"). The Permit Holder submits the following information regarding the progress of Project.

Construction is anticipated to be completed by the first week of June. Upon completion of construction, the Permit Holder will notify the Illinois Department of Public Health Design Standards Unit that the Project is ready for its life safety code inspection. All required approvals are anticipated to occur to allow the Permit Holder to transfer residents from the existing facility to the relocated facility during the week of August 18, 2025.

To date, the Permit Holder has expended \$22,500,000 on the Project.
