Attached are two State Board Staff Reports (SBSRs) for the above mentioned projects. Both are discontinuations without any negative findings, and are eligible for your individual review.

1. #23-044 Surgicore, Inc., Chicago: The Applicant proposes to discontinue a single-specialty ASTC in Chicago. The ASTC provided Podiatric surgical services, and the owner (Dr. Michael Wood), is scaling down his business operation in preparation for his retirement. If approved, the facility will continue as physician offices until the MD decides to retire from his practice. There are no costs to this project.
2. #23-048 DaVita Manteno Dialysis, Manteno: The Applicants propose to discontinue a 15-station ESRD facility in Manteno, citing declining utilization due to a growing trend toward home dialysis, persistent staffing shortages since the pandemic, and an expiring building lease that the applicants have not renewed. Board staff note the presence of underutilized ESRD facilities in the service area, and despite the increase in number of excess stations in the planning area expected to result from this transaction, if approved, their exit from the market should ensure increased utilization at the remaining facilities in the 17-mile service area, and the health service area (HSA). There are no costs associated with this project.
