On May 21, 2023, the Chairwoman of the Illinois Health Facilities and Services Review Board (“State Board”) acting on behalf of the State Board approved your request for the change of ownership of Northwest Surgicare, 1100 West Central Road, Arlington Heights, Illinois. The approval was based upon the application's compliance with applicable provisions of 77 IAC 1130. Northwest Surgicare has been approved for General Surgery, Ophthalmology, Orthopedic, OB/Gynecology, Oral/Maxillofacial Pain Management, Plastic Surgery, Urology, Otolaryngology, Neurology, and Podiatry surgical specialties.

You are reminded that this exemption for the change of ownership shall be invalid if the exemption holder fails to submit a statement to the Board within 90 days after the completion date of the change of ownership, or such longer period as provided by the Board, certifying that the change of ownership has been completed. Failure to provide the required notification shall subject the exemption holder to the sanctions provided under Section 14 of the Illinois Health Facilities Planning Act. The exemption holder is also reminded that 77 IAC 1130.140 defines transactions that constitute a change of ownership of a health care facility. You should become familiar with those definitions.

The State Board's approval does not exempt the transaction from any other regulatory, certification or licensure requirements that may be applicable prior to acquisition.
