THE COURT: Good afternoon. My name is George Roate. I am accompanied by Mr. John Kniery, Board Administrator; Ms. Blanca Dominguez, Board Legal Counsel; and Mike Constantino, Senior Reviewer. We are from the Illinois Department of Public Health and represent the Illinois Health Facilities and Services Review Board. We are here to conduct a public hearing on the proposed project known as Exemption E-016-24 Ascension Holy Family Medical Center, Des Plaines. As per the rules of the Illinois Health Facilities and Services Review Board, I would like to read the legal notice into record.

Prime HealthCare Services Incorporated is purchasing Ascension Holy Family Medical Center located at 100 North River Road in Des Plaines at a cost of \$13,566,799. This transaction is germane with Prime HealthCare's proposal to purchase nine hospitals and two surgery centers located throughout the metropolitan

1 Chicagoland area at a total cost of
2 approximately \$375 million.

3 A public hearing will take place
4 pursuant to Illinois Code 3960. The hearing
5 is scheduled for Wednesday, September 25th,
6 at 1:00 p.m. to 3:00 p.m. at the Des Plaines
7 Public Library, 1501 Ellinwood Street, Des
8 Plaines.

9 The public hearing is to be held
10 at the Illinois Department of Public Health
11 pursuant to the Illinois Facilities Planning
12 Act. The hearing is open to the public and
13 will afford an opportunity for parties with
14 interest to present written and/or verbal
15 comment relevant to the project. All
16 allegations or assertions shall be relevant
17 to the need for the proposed project and be
18 supported with two copies of documentation or
19 materials that are printed or typed on paper
20 size 8 1/2 inches by 11 inches.
21 Consideration by the state board has been
22 tentatively scheduled for the October 29th,
23 2024, Illinois Health Facilities and Services
24 Review Board Meeting.

1 If you have not done so, please
2 sign in using the appropriate registration
3 forms. One form is for individuals who want
4 to provide testimony in favor or opposition
5 to the project. The last form is for
6 individuals to register their attendance who
7 did not wish to testify.

8 To ensure that the Illinois Health
9 Facilities and Services Review Board public
10 hearings protect the privacy and maintain the
11 confidentiality of an individual's health
12 information. Covered entities as defined by
13 the health insurance portability act of 1976,
14 such as facilities, hospital providers,
15 health plans and health care clearinghouses,
16 submitting oral or written testimony that
17 disclose protected health information of
18 individuals shall have written valid
19 authorization from that individual. The
20 authorization shall allow the covered entity
21 to share the individual's protected health
22 information at this hearing.

23 Those of you who came with
24 prepared text for your preparation may choose

1 to submit the text without giving testimony.
2 As per the legal notice, I would appreciate
3 two copies of your testimony. When you make
4 your presentation, please give the court
5 reporter the spelling of your complete name.
6 We have identified a chief spokesperson for
7 the applicant and we would like that
8 individual to make the first presentation.
9 The remaining testimony will be taken in
10 order of the names on the registration.
11 Please hold your questions until all
12 testimony is presented, and we will call the
13 first speaker.

14 Ms. Julie Mirostaw?

15 MS. MIROSTAW: Hello. My name is Julie
16 Mirostaw -- it's J-U-L-I-E,
17 M-I-R-O-S-T-A-W -- and I serve as the chief
18 advocacy officer for Ascension Illinois. I'd
19 like to start by thanking the Illinois Health
20 Services and Review Board for the opportunity
21 to speak to you on behalf of our Ascension
22 Illinois hospitals. I'm happy to be here to
23 share with you how we came to the decision to
24 transfer ownership of nine of our 14

1 hospitals to Prime HealthCare.

2 In order to ensure our mission of
3 serving those most vulnerable continues to
4 flourish, we continue to explore new options
5 to best serve our communities as we adapt to
6 the rapidly changing healthcare environment.
7 After thorough due diligence, a values
8 compatibility assessment, and an ethics
9 discernment process, Ascension selected Prime
10 HealthCare as the best steward for these
11 facilities for the future. Prime HealthCare
12 is well positioned to serve our communities
13 through an integrated care delivery system to
14 ensure that the Greater Chicago Area has
15 sustainable quality healthcare access for
16 generations to come. Thank you.

17 MR. ROATE: Thank you.

18 Next, the Board would like to call
19 Mr. Steve Aleman.

20 MR. ALEMAN: Good afternoon. My name
21 is Steve Aleman. I'm the chief financial
22 officer of Prime HealthCare, and first and
23 foremost, Prime HealthCare considers it an
24 honor and a tremendous responsibility to have

1 been selected by Ascension Health as the
2 stewards of its Illinois facilities, their
3 employees and patients, and their combined
4 legacy of service to their communities.

5 Prime HealthCare was founded in
6 2001 with a mission of saving, improving, and
7 investing in community hospitals. We have
8 since delivered on that mission, growing to
9 an integrated delivery system including 44
10 hospitals in 14 states, more than 300
11 outpatient locations, and nearly 45,000
12 employees and physicians.

13 We are excited to welcome the
14 Ascension facilities into our Prime
15 HealthCare family, and we strongly believe we
16 are uniquely positioned to serve these
17 hospitals and their communities to ensure
18 that the Greater Chicago Area continues to
19 have sustainable quality healthcare access
20 far into the future. We have done this for
21 communities across the nation and are
22 confident that we can deliver for the
23 residents of Chicagoland and beyond.

24 It is Prime HealthCare's

1 unwavering dedication to providing
2 compassionate quality care, building value,
3 preserving access, and improving health
4 outcomes that allows Prime to consistently be
5 nationally ranked among the best hospital
6 systems in the nation. Prime HealthCare has
7 been named a Top 10 and Top 15 health system
8 by Truven Health Analytics. Our hospitals
9 have been named among the nation's top 100
10 hospitals 69 times, and receive more patient
11 safety excellence awards from Healthgrades
12 than any other system in the past eight
13 years. In 2023 alone, we received more than
14 500 clinical quality awards from national
15 organizations such as The Leapfrog Group, U.
16 S. News & World Report, and many more.

17 Prime has also been recognized as
18 a top 10 health system in the nation by the
19 Lown Institute with A grades for health
20 equity, social responsibility, patient and
21 clinical outcomes, and inclusivity. Prime
22 HealthCare is not only bringing this
23 commitment to quality and health equity to
24 the Ascension Illinois facilities; we have

1 also committed to investing \$250 million in
2 the Ascension facilities to fund capital
3 improvements, including substantial
4 technology investments and system upgrades,
5 as well as hiring all of the acquired
6 facility's workforce subject to Prime
7 standard hiring practices, policies, and
8 titles.

9 Prime HealthCare has also
10 committed to continuing all services at the
11 facility and, pending our internal review,
12 hope to expand services based on community
13 needs. We have also committed to maintaining
14 levels of charity care and continuing
15 existing charity care and community benefit
16 programs, preserving these facilities' roles
17 as valued community partners.

18 This is not an exceptional
19 commitment. It is what we do for all the
20 communities we serve. In fact, Prime
21 HealthCare has provided more than \$12 billion
22 in charity care and community benefits since
23 2010, and nearly \$2 billion in capital
24 improvements since 2005 to transform

1 hospitals and ensure health equity and care
2 in communities across the country.

3 Since 2001, Prime HealthCare has
4 also rescued various Catholic hospitals,
5 respecting the traditions of these historic
6 facilities while promoting the spiritual care
7 and well-being of all members of the
8 community, including the most vulnerable on
9 the margins of society. We pledge to do this
10 for the Ascension facilities as well.

11 I want to close with the words of
12 our founder, which is "If you can see the
13 potential for good, feel the impact of
14 kindness on others, touch the spirit of a
15 generous cause just a bit every day, then you
16 have embarked on a noble path." This
17 perfectly encapsulates the dedication to
18 compassionate care and social responsibility
19 at the heart of Prime HealthCare's mission.
20 We look forward to sharing that dedication to
21 caring and improving our communities with all
22 the patients who depend on these hospitals
23 and facilities for generations to come.
24 Thank you.

1 MR. ROATE: Thank you.

2 Next, the Board would like to call
3 Yolande Wilson-Stubbs.

4 MS. WILSON-STUBBS: Good afternoon. My
5 name is Yolande Wilson-Stubbs and I am the
6 president at Holy Family Hospital. We thank
7 the Board for providing us this opportunity
8 to hear from our community today during this
9 public hearing and look forward to appearing
10 before the Board. Their support of the
11 transfer of ownership preserves jobs and
12 ensures needed healthcare across the
13 Chicagoland area as well as investment in
14 Illinois for the future. Thank you.

15 MR. ROATE: Thank you.

16 Is there anyone who wishes to
17 testify who has not had an opportunity?

18 Seeing none, is there anyone who
19 wishes -- anyone who has testified who
20 wishes to provide additional testimony?

21 I would remind everyone to submit
22 your written comments to us so that we have
23 this information for the record. Also, this
24 project is scheduled for consideration by the

1 Illinois Health Facilities and Services
2 Review Board at its October 29th, 2024,
3 meeting. This meeting will be held at the
4 municipal Bolingbrook Golf Club, 2001 Rodeo
5 Drive, Bolingbrook, Illinois.

6 The public has until October 9th,
7 2024, to submit written comments. These
8 comments can be sent to my attention at the
9 Illinois Health Facilities and Services
10 Review Board, care of the Illinois Department
11 of Public Health, 525 West Jefferson Street,
12 2nd floor, Springfield, Illinois 62761. If
