

PUBLIC HEARING OF THE ILLINOIS
HEALTH FACILITIES AND SERVICES REVIEW BOARD

REPORT OF PROCEEDINGS had and
testimony taken at the Public Hearing of
the above-entitled cause, taken on
Tuesday, the 17th day of September, 2024,
at the hour of 1:00 P.M., reported by
GLORIA APOSTOLOS SIOLIDIS, CSR License No.
084-001205, duly qualified and commissioned
for the State of Illinois.

1 ADMINISTRATOR KINERY: Good afternoon.

2 My name is John Kinery, Administrator of
3 the Board. I'm accompanied by Dr. Audrey
4 Tanksley, Madame Board Member, Blanca
5 Dominguez, our General Counsel, and Sharie
6 Ryan, our Board Executive Coordinator.

7 We are from the Illinois Health
8 Facilities and Services Review Board, and
9 we're here today done conduct a public
10 hearing on the proposed project known as
11 E-018-24, Ascension Saint Mary Hospital,
12 Chicago. Ascension from now on.

13 As for the Rules of the Health
14 Facilities and Services Review Board, I
15 would like to read the Legal Notice into
16 the record.

17 Prime Healthcare Services, Inc.
18 is purchasing Ascension Saint Mary's
19 Hospital, located at 2233 West Division
20 Street, Chicago, at a cost of
21 \$71,726,210.00.

22 This transaction is germane with
23 Prime Healthcare Inc.'s proposal to
24 purchase nine hospitals and two ambulatory

1 surgical centers located throughout the
2 Metropolitan Chicago area, at a cost of
3 approximately \$375 million.

4 A public hearing will take place
5 pursuant to the 20 Illinois Administrative
6 Code 3960. The hearing is scheduled for
7 Tuesday, September 17th, 2024 from
8 1:00 P.M. to 3:00 P.M. at the Chicago
9 Public Library, Manning branch, located at
10 6 South Hoyne Avenue, Chicago.

11 This public hearing is to be held
12 by the Department of Public Health pursuant
13 to the Illinois Health Facilities Planning
14 Act.

15 The hearing is open to the
16 public, and we will afford an opportunity
17 for all parties with interest to present
18 written and/or verbal comments relevant to
19 the project.

20 All allegations or assertions
21 should be relevant to the need for the
22 proposed project and be supported with two
23 copies of documentation or materials that
24 are printed on typed paper 8 1/2 by 11.

1 Consideration by the State Board
2 has been tentatively scheduled for the
3 October 29th, 2024 meeting of the Health
4 Facilities and Services Review Board.

5 If it has not been done so,
6 please sign in using the appropriate
7 registration forms.

8 One form is for an individual who
9 wants to perform testimony in favor or
10 opposition of the project. The last form
11 is for individuals to register just their
12 attendance, but do not wish to testify.

13 To insure that the Health
14 Facilities and Services Review Board public
15 hearing protect the privacy and maintain
16 the confidentiality of an individual's
17 health information, covered entities as
18 defined by the Health Insurance Portability
19 Act of 1996 such as facilities, hospital
20 providers, health plans, healthcare
21 clearing houses, submitting oral or written
22 testimony that discloses protected health
23 information of individuals, shall have a
24 valid written authorization from the

1 individual.

2 The authorization shall allow the
3 covered entity to share the individual's
4 protected health information at this
5 hearing.

6 Those of you who came with
7 prepared text for your presentation may
8 choose to submit the text without giving
9 testimony. However, if you are giving oral
10 testimony, please be as brief as possible.
11 As per the Legal Notice, I would appreciate
12 two copies of your testimony.

13 When you make a presentation,
14 please give the court reporter the spelling
15 of your complete name.

16 If there is a chief spokesperson
17 version for the applicants, we would like
18 that individual to make the first
19 presentation.

20 The remaining testimony will be
21 taken in the order the names have been
22 registered. Please hold your questions
23 until all testimony is presented.

24 And if there is someone who

1 represents the applicant who wishes to make
2 the first presentation, please come
3 forward. Thank you.

4 MS. DAVENPORT: Good afternoon
5 everyone. My name is Polly Davenport,
6 P-o-l-l-y D-a-v-e-n-p-o-r-t. I am the CEO
7 for Ascension Illinois.

8 I'm happy to be here today to
9 share with you why we are here on behalf --
10 well, first of all, let me say on behalf of
11 the Illinois Health Facility Services and
12 Review Board, I appreciate the opportunity
13 to speak to you regarding our Ascension
14 Illinois Hospitals.

15 I want to share with you how we
16 came to this decision to transfer ownership
17 of nine of our 14 facilities to Prime
18 Healthcare.

19 In order to insure our mission of
20 serving those most vulnerable continues to
21 flourish, we continue to explore new
22 options to best serve our community as we
23 adapt to the rapidly-changing healthcare
24 environment.

1 After thorough due diligence, a
2 values compatible assessment, and an ethics
3 discernment process, Ascension selected
4 Prime Healthcare as the best steward of
5 these facilities for the future.

6 Prime Healthcare is well
7 positioned to serve our communities through
8 an integrated care delivery system to
9 ensure the Greater Chicago area has
10 sustainable quality healthcare access for
11 generations to come.

12 Thank you.

13 ADMINISTRATOR KINERY: Thank you. The
14 Board calls Fred Ortega.

15 MR. ORTEGA: Thank you.

16 The name is Fred Ortega. F-r-e-d
17 O-r-t-e-g-a. And I am the senior director
18 of government affairs for Prime Healthcare.

19 I want to thank the Board and
20 Board staff for organizing these meetings.

21 And I am here on behalf of Prime
22 Healthcare to share that we consider it an
23 honor and tremendous responsibility to have
24 been selected by Ascension Health as the

1 stewards of its Illinois facilities, their
2 employees and patients, and their combined
3 legacy of service to the communities.

4 Prime Healthcare was founded in
5 2001 with a mission of saving, improving
6 and investing in community hospitals. We
7 have since delivered on that mission,
8 growing into an integrated delivery system
9 including 44 hospitals in 14 states, more
10 than 300 outpatient locations, and nearly
11 45,000 employees and physicians.

12 We are excited to welcome the
13 Ascension facilities into our Prime
14 Healthcare family, and we strongly believe
15 we are uniquely positioned to serve these
16 hospitals and their communities to ensure
17 that the Greater Chicago area continues to
18 have sustainable quality healthcare access
19 far in the future.

20 We have done this for communities
21 across the nation, and are confident that
22 we can deliver for the residents of
23 Chicagoland and beyond.

24 It is Prime Healthcare's

1 unwavering dedication to providing
2 compassionate quality care, building value,
3 preserve access and improving health
4 outcomes that allows us to consistently be
5 nationally ranked among the best hospital
6 systems in the nation.

7 Prime Healthcare has been named
8 a top 10 in top 15 health systems by Truman
9 Health Analytics.

10 Our hospitals have been named
11 among the nation`s 100 top hospitals 69
12 times, and have received more patient
13 safety excellence awards from health grades
14 than any other health system in the past
15 eight years.

16 In 2023 alone we received more
17 than 500 clinical quality awards from
18 national organizations, such as the
19 Leapfrog Group, U.S. News and World Report,
20 and many others.

21 Prime has also been recognized
22 as a top 10 health systems in the nation by
23 the Loan Institute with A grades for health
24 equity, social responsibility, patient and

1 clinical outcomes, and inclusivity.

2 Prime Healthcare is not only
3 bringing this commitment to quality and
4 healthcare to the Ascension Illinois
5 facilities, we have also committed to
6 investing \$250 million in the Ascension
7 facilities to fund capital improvements,
8 including substantial technology
9 investments and system upgrades, as well as
10 hiring all the acquired facility`s
11 workforce, subject to Prime`s standard
12 hiring practices, policies and titles.

13 Prime Healthcare is also
14 committed to continuing all services at
15 Ascension Saint Mary, and pending our
16 internal review, hope to expand services
17 based on community needs.

18 We have also committed to
19 maintaining levels of charity care and
20 continuing existing charity care and
21 community benefit programs, preserving
22 these facilities` roles as valued community
23 partners.

24 In fact, Prime Healthcare has

1 provided more than \$12 billion in charity
2 care and community benefits since 2010, and
3 nearly \$2 billion in capital improvement
4 since 2005 to transform hospitals and
5 insure health equity and care in
6 communities we serve across the country.

7 Since 2001, Prime Healthcare has
8 also rescued various Catholic hospitals,
9 respecting the traditions of these historic
10 facilities, while promoting the spiritual
11 care and well-being of all members of the
12 community, including the most vulnerable on
13 the margins of society.

14 We pledge to do this for the
15 Ascension facility as well.

16 I want to close with the words of
17 our founder. If you can see the potential
18 for good, feel the impact of kindness on
19 others, touch the spirit of a generous
20 cause just a bit every day and you have
21 embarked on a noble path.

22 This perfectly encapsulates the
23 dedication and compassion and care and
24 social responsibility at the heart of Prime

1 Healthcare's mission.

2 We look forward to sharing that
3 dedication to caring and improving our
4 communities with all the patients who
5 depend on our facilities for generations
6 to come.

7 Thank you.

8 ADMINISTRATOR KINERY: The Board calls
9 Ellis Hawkins.

10 MR. HAWKINS: Good afternoon.

11 Ellis Hawkins. E-l-l-i-s
12 H-a-w-k-i-n-s. I'm the president of
13 Saint Mary's, Chicago.

14 We thank the Board for providing
15 us the opportunity to hear our community
16 today during this public hearing and look
17 forward to appearing before the Board.

18 Your support of this transfer of
19 ownership preserves jobs and ensures needed
20 healthcare access across Chicagoland, as
21 well as the investment in Illinois for the
22 future. Thank you.

23 ADMINISTRATOR KINERY: Is there anyone
24 else who wishes to testify and has not had

1 the opportunity?

2 Seeing none, is there anyone who
3 has testified who wishes to provide
4 additional testimony?

5 I would remind everyone to submit
6 your written comments so that they would
7 have this information for the record.

8 And also, this project is
9 scheduled for consideration by the Illinois
10 Health Facilities and Services Review Board
11 at its October 29th, 2024 meeting.

12 This will be held at the
13 Municipal Bolingbrook Golf Club, 2001 Rodeo
14 Drive, Bolingbrook, Illinois.

15 The public has until October 9th,
16 2024 to submit written comments.
