This is to acknowledge receipt of the above-referenced application on February 7, 2025 for a permit under the Illinois Health Facilities Planning Act ("Act") [20 ILCS 3960, *et seq.*].

After reviewing the submitted documentation, the staff of the Health Facilities & Services Review Board ("HFSRB" or "State Board") has deemed the permit application substantially complete as of February 10, 2025, and ready for review as outlined in the Act and Part 1130 of Title 77 of the Illinois Administrative Code ("Code").

We previously received your check for \$2,500.00. The balance of the required fee has been determined to be **\$30,107.70**. **To avoid a possible invalidation of the permit, the payment must be made to the "Illinois Department of Public Health" within thirty (30) days of receiving this notice.** The check should be made out in the exact amount, as rounding off dollar amounts complicates our records unnecessarily.

This letter also serves to notify you that the above-referenced permit application is now in the review period. During the review period, HFSRB staff will conduct a comprehensive review of the project and prepare a report of findings for submission to the HFSRB. See 77 Ill. Adm. Code §§1130.610-650. Please note that HFSRB staff may request additional information during the review period.

The permit applicant can review a copy of the report and appear before HFSRB to answer questions regarding the proposed project.

The HFSRB Staff Report and any related materials for this project will be posted on the HFSRB website within fourteen (14) days before the HFSRB meeting at which the proposed project will be heard.

The HFSRB staff has tentatively scheduled the consideration of the above project for presentation to the State Board at the May 6, 2025 meeting. It will be noted on the corresponding agenda posted on the HFSRB website as outlined in the Open Meetings Act [5 ILCS 120/].



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Under applicable law and administrative rules, a public hearing about the above-referenced project may be requested. See Subpart I of Part 1130 of Title 77 of the Code. If a public hearing is requested, HFSRB staff will notify you regarding the time and place for the public hearing.

Per the requirements of the Illinois Health Facilities Planning Act [20 ILCS 3960/], notice is given of receipt to add beds to an existing Medically Complex/Skilled Nursing (MC/DD) facility in Elgin. Project #25-005, Marklund Wasmond Center, Elgin. Applicants: Marklund Charities and Marklund Children's Home d/b/a Marklund Wasmond Center. The Applicants propose to add 24 skilled nursing beds to an existing 61-bed facility located at 1435 Summit Street, Elgin. Project cost: \$14,821,679.

The application contained a Safety Net Impact Statement and was deemed substantially complete on February 10, 2025.
