This is to acknowledge receipt of the above-referenced application on April 8, 2026, for a permit under the Illinois Health Facilities Planning Act ("Act") [20 ILCS 3960, *et seq.*].

After reviewing the submitted documentation, the staff of the Health Facilities & Services Review Board ("HFSRB" or "State Board") has deemed the permit application substantially complete as of April 10, 2026, and ready for review as outlined in the Act and Part 1130 of Title 77 of the Illinois Administrative Code ("Code").

We previously received your check for \$5,000.00. The balance of the required fee has been determined to be **\$7,090.89**. **To avoid a possible invalidation of the permit, the payment must be made to the "Illinois Department of Public Health" within thirty (30) days of receiving this notice.** The check should be made out in the exact amount, as rounding off dollar amounts complicates our records unnecessarily.

This letter also serves to notify you that the above-referenced permit application is now in the review period. During the review period, HFSRB staff will conduct a comprehensive review of the project and prepare a report of findings for submission to the HFSRB. See 77 Ill. Adm. Code §§1130.610-650. Please note that HFSRB staff may request additional information during the review period.

The permit applicant can review a copy of the report and appear before HFSRB to answer questions regarding the proposed project.

The HFSRB Staff Report and any related materials for this project will be posted on the HFSRB website within fourteen (14) days before the HFSRB meeting at which the proposed project will be heard.



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The HFSRB staff has tentatively scheduled the above project for presentation to the State Board on **September 15, 2026**. It will be noted on the corresponding agenda posted on the HFSRB website as outlined in the Open Meetings Act [5 ILCS 120/].

Under applicable law and administrative rules, a public hearing about the above-referenced project may be requested. See Subpart I of Part 1130 of Title 77 of the Code. If a public hearing is requested, HFSRB staff will notify you of the time and place.

Please note that modifications prior to the presentation of the proposed project to the State Board must comply with all modification requirements, including, but not limited to, 77 Ill. Adm. Code 650.

In accordance with the requirements of the Illinois Health Facilities Planning Act, notice is given of receipt to establish an Ambulatory Surgery Treatment Center (ASTC), in Chicago. Project #26-018, River Oaks Surgery Center, Chicago. Applicants: River Oaks Surgery Center, LLC. The applicant proposes to establish a 2-room-limited-specialty ASTC in 6,956 GSF of newly constructed space, located at 7941 South Western Avenue, Chicago. Project cost: \$5,495,857.

The application contained a Safety Net Impact Statement and was declared complete on April 10, 2026.
